Page 3 1 (Time noted 9:26 a.m.) 2 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: With that, we call a 3 series of cases, Tap Rock Resources, Case 21940, which I believe is combined with 21949, 21950, 21951. 4 5 Mr. Bruce. MR. BRUCE: Yes, I'm here on behalf of Tap Rock. 6 7 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Are those four cases combined? 8 9 MR. BRUCE: Yes. 10 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Are there any other interested parties in 11 Cases 21940, 21949, 21950, 21951? (Note: Pause.) 12 13 Silence. So you may proceed, Mr. Bruce. MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, in these cases Tap 14 15 Rock seeks to force pool the east half/west half of 16 Section 34 and 24 South, 25 East, and the east 17 half/northwest quarter of Section 3 of 25 South, 35 East, both as to the -- what the Division has called the Middle 18 19 Bone Spring, and also, uh -- the Middle Bone Spring Formation, and the separate well in the Wolf Bone 20 21 Formation. This is one of the areas where the Lower Third 22 Bone Spring has been included with the Wolfcamp. 23 In the other set of -- the other two cases, 24 again force pooling of Bone Spring and a Wolf Bone well in 25 the west half/west half of Section 34 and west

Page 4 half/northwest quarter of Section 3. 1 2 The exhibit packages. 3 Exhibit A are the applications. Exhibit B is the affidavit of Erica Hixson, 4 5 landman with Tap Rock, containing all the usual C-102s, ownership information. б 7 The only party being force pooled in 8 this -- in all four cases is the New Mexico Department of Transportation. There is -- they have a right-of-way 9 under a road. Let's see. They own a right-of-way under a 10 portion of Highway 128, State Highway 128. It's a very 11 12 small interest. 13 This happens sometimes with the highway 14 department. Instead of being a right-of-way grant it's 15 actually a deed conveying full title, and so they own that 16 interest, uh, like it's fee land. This is not subject to 17 the jurisdiction of the State Land Office. 18 That is the only party they seek to force 19 pool. They proposed the wells, never heard from 20 21 the Department of Transportation, and so they are seeking pooling of this small interest. 22 23 Again, the land affidavit contains all the usual AFEs and all the other items, and then Exhibit C is 24 25 the affidavit of Emily Lange, the geologist, and she

Page 5 presents geologic evidence on both the Bone Spring and the 1 2 Wolfbone Formation. 3 Exhibit 4 (sic) is my Affidavit of Notice, 4 and the -- again, the only party is the Department of Transportation, and they did receive actual Notice. 5 Then Exhibit 5 (sic) contains all of the 6 7 pooling checklists. 8 One thing on these, I was doing these rather late one night, and I forgot to sign the ones I 9 originally submitted. I noticed that this morning, and so 10 I have refiled a replacement Exhibit 5 with signed --11 12 signed with checklists. But with that, I think the application packet is complete, and I move the admission 13 14 of Exhibits A through F and ask that the matters be taken 15 under advisement. 16 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. 17 Mr. Lowe, any questions. EXAMINER LOWE: Uhm, Mr. Bruce? 18 MR. BRUCE: Yes. 19 EXAMINER LOWE: I'm -- you indicated that you're 20 21 missing the first page of -- not missing. The first page of Exhibit 5; is that correct? 22 23 MR. BRUCE: I did not sign page 3 of each 24 pooling checklist, so this morning I filed a complete -- I 25 didn't file just the signature page, i filed complete

Page 6 1 pooling checklists. 2 So that was at about 7:30 this morning. 3 EXAMINER LOWE: Okay. I just want to understand 4 sand which portion you intend to, I guess --MR. BRUCE: I had just forgotten to sign them 5 all. б 7 EXAMINER LOWE: That's fine. I just wanted to know which one in particular, where they are located in 8 your exhibits to find out where ... 9 MR. BRUCE: Exhibit E. 10 EXAMINER LOWE: Okay. I'm looking through 11 12 exhibits right now, so... 13 Okay. That's all the questions I have for 14 that. Thank you for clarifying that, Mr. Bruce. 15 MR BRUCE: Thank you. 16 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. 17 So, Mr. Bruce, your client has had no 18 contact with the Department of Transportation? 19 MR. BRUCE: There is a Proposal Letter to the Department of Transportation, and they have tried to 20 contact them many times. 21 And I'm kind of familiar with this. I've 22 force pooled the Department of Transportation many times, 23 24 and they just -- they are uncertain what they are doing 25 and so they do nothing. So they never respond.

Page 7 1 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. I just want 2 to make sure that we don't end up getting grief from a 3 sister agency here. MR. BRUCE: I understand. 4 5 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Not that they are going to come in with a competing pooling application, 6 7 but... 8 MR. BRUCE: No. No. HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. So is 9 there anyone else interested, have comments on Cases 10 21940, 21949, 21950, 21950? (Note: Pause.) 11 12 Hearing none, the exhibits are admitted into the record, I assume also including the one you 13 submitted this morning. 14 15 MR. BRUCE: Yes. 16 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Cases 21950, 21949, 17 21950, 21951 are taken under advisement. Thank you. 18 MR. BRUCE: Thank you. (Time noted 9:33 a.m.) 19 20 21 22 23 24 25
