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Page 3 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: With that we will 1 2 move on to starting with Item 18 on the agenda's cases 21325, 21326, 21327, 21328, Mewbourne Oil Company. However, 3 4 these cases are connected by a prehearing order to some other cases that I think have already been rescheduled so we 5 6 can discuss that. So Mewbourne Oil Company, who is here? 7 MR. BRUCE: Jim Bruce here, Mr. Examiner. 8 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. And then I have EOG Resources? 9 10 MR. FELDEWERT: Yes. May it please the Examiner, Michael Feldewert with the Santa Fe office of Holland & Hart 11 12 appearing on behalf of EOG Resources Inc. 13 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: And then I think I 14 see something here for MRC Delaware. Are they on these 15 cases? MS. BENNETT: Mr. Examiner, this Deana Bennett 16 again on behalf of Colgate. I did enter appearances in 17 these cases recently. As you noted at the outset, these 18 cases are tide to certain Colgate cases, and in looking 19 through the case files last week and this week, I noticed 20 that we didn't have an entry of appearance in the case 21 files, so I filed entries of appearance on behalf of Colgate 22 23 in these cases and they were approved, but it was relatively 24 recently. 25 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. I did

Page 4 notice that. Okay. All right. So there is a prehearing 1 2 order that covers these cases, and I believe it's 21072, 074, 075 and 092. And then there was a motion to vacate the 3 4 prehearing order, and then there was an attempt -- at least 5 the other case were continued to a later date. Is that 6 correct, Ms. Bennett? 7 MS. BENNETT: That's right. The Colgate cases were continued to October 21. And I -- I'm sorry go ahead. 8 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Are there ongoing 9 10 discussions with the parties? MS. BENNETT: Yes, there are. 11 12 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. So Mr. -- so 13 would you like to speak on the discussions? Do you want us 14 to vacate, totally drop the prehearing order or --15 MR. BRUCE: Yes, Mr. Examiner, and I meant to file my own continuances on behalf of Mewbourne for the 16 17 October 21 hearing just like the other cases which are in the name of Colgate, but I just got swept away with getting 18 back from vacation and getting ready for today's hearings. 19 So I would ask that the order be vacated, and 20 then today I will, I will file motions to continue these 21 22 four case. 23 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Ms. Bennett, are you 24 agreement with that? 25 MS. BENNETT: That's fine with Colgate. That was

3	MR. FELDEWERT: I'm looking at the file here, and
4	I apologize, it was actually EOG Resources who filed the
5	motion to vacate the prehearing order. And just for the
6	record we have also appeared for MRC Delaware resources LLC.
7	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. So I wasn't
8	crazy there, I did have you LISTED correctly.
9	MR. FELDEWERT: You were correct.
10	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. So, all
11	right, so I assume everyone is in agreement that we will
12	continue these cases to October 21, continue to link them
13	together, but not necessarily under a prehearing order.
14	MR. BRUCE: I think that's right. The parties
15	are in discussion.
16	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Is that all
17	right, Ms. Bennett?
18	MS. BENNETT: That's fine with Colgate. Thank
19	you very much.
20	MR. FELDEWERT: Do you need the case numbers, Mr.
21	Examiner, for the Colgate cases?
22	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Are they different
23	than I have 21072, 074, 075 and 092.
24	MR. FELDEWERT: Yes, yes.
25	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Because they are all
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1	on a prehearing order from the distant past. With that, the
2	cases will be continued to October 21, and the prehearing
3	order will be vacated. Once again, are there any other
4	comments, any other persons on cases 21325, 21326, 21327,
5	21328?

8	everyone.
9	MS. BENNETT: Thank you.
10	MR. FELDEWERT: Thank you.
