- 2 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. With that I will
- 3 call Item No. 39, Case 22017, Kaiser Francis Oil Company.
- 4 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce here on
- 5 behalf of Kaiser Francis, and I'm presenting the case by
- 6 affidavit.
- 7 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. I see no other
- 8 parties. Are there any other interested persons in Case
- 9 22017? (Note: Pause.) Hearing none, Mr. Bruce you may
- 10 proceed
- MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, I filed the exhibit
- 12 package. Exhibit 1 is the Application and Proposed Notice
- 13 in this case. Applicant seeks to force pool the
- 14 west half/southwest quarter of Section 24 and the
- 15 west half/west half of Section 25, 23 South, 28 East,
- 16 pooling the Delaware Formation.
- 17 The well is the Brantley Fee 2425 LBC Well
- 18 No. 1H, which will be completed in the lower portion of
- 19 the Brushy Canyon zone of the Delaware Formation.
- 20 Exhibit 2 it the landman's affidavit. It
- 21 contains all the usual information on the well, the
- overhead rates, which are \$8,000 and \$800 a month.
- They seek the maximum risk charge.
- 24 It contains all the usual exhibits: The
- 25 C-102, a history here, a summary -- showing the interests

- 1 being force pooled and the percentage interest; the
- 2 Summary of Communications, together with the Letters and
- 3 AFE. That is the affidavit of Brendon Kushnerick, who has
- 4 previously testified before the Division.
- 5 Then next is the Verified Statement of Lee
- 6 \*\* Whitman, the geologist on this prospect, and it
- 7 contains the usual structure map, isopach, cross section,
- 8 and directional drilling information showing that this
- 9 reservoir is capable of being developed by horizontal
- 10 drilling, and each quarter/quarter section will contribute
- 11 more or less equally to production.
- 12 Exhibit 4 is my Affidavit of Notice.
- 13 Notice was sent out, and I received back, wonder of all
- 14 wonders, all the green cards.
- 15 But also Exhibit 5 is an Affidavit of
- 16 Publication showing that all the parties did receive
- 17 Publication Notice also.
- 18 And finally Exhibit 5 is my Compulsory
- 19 Pooling Checklist. I truly hope it's correct. That's
- 20 usually the last thing I do in these hearings. Some of
- 21 them come out incorrectly.
- I think everything is in the package, and I
- 23 would merely request that Exhibits 1 through 6 be entered
- 24 into the record and this matter be taken under advisement.
- 25 .

- 1 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 2 Ms. Murphy, questions?
- 3 MS. MURPHY: I have a couple of questions.
- 4 Mr. Bruce is Attachment C, is that the
- 5 percentage of the working interests that you're pooling?
- 6 Page 10.
- 7.
- 8 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Bruce, are you with us?
- 9 MR. BRUCE: Sorry. I was muted.
- 10 Yes, Attachment C shows the six entities
- 11 and their working interests who are being pooled, and were
- 12 notified of the hearing.
- MS. MURPHY: So what percentage does Kaiser
- 14 Francis own overall in the spacing unit?
- 15 MR. BRUCE: Well, doing the math real quick in
- 16 my head, about 70, 72 percent.
- MS. MURPHY: Okay. I have one other request.
- On page 8, and I'm certainly not picking on
- 19 you, but we need to move away from the Midland maps. They
- 20 are just not useful at this point; the data is out of
- 21 date. And so I'll request that documents I see from now
- 22 on -- and also it was affirmed when Mr. Brooks was still
- 23 here that they requested not to use the Midland maps any
- 24 more.
- 25 And there is other sources of maps with

- 1 useful information that you can use, and you can find
- 2 those on the OCD website and also at the State Land Office
- 3 has good maps available for you to use with actual lease
- 4 information and tract ownership.
- 5 So I'll request that you submit the
- 6 Attachment A (sic) in I think it's these two cases.
- 7 Thank you.
- 8 MR. BRUCE: One case. One case.
- 9 MS. MURPHY: I think it's two cases coming up.
- 10 I'm confused.
- 11 MR. BRUCE: I will do that. I never recalled
- 12 Mr. Brooks saying that.
- MS. MURPHY: You know, Mr. Goetz told me that
- 14 they had affirmed that they should move away from the
- 15 Midland maps. And at this stage you might as well just
- 16 put a quilt pattern or a newspaper pattern behind them,
- 17 because they are not useful. And we actually do use a lot
- 18 of -- examiners do look at these maps, which is a good
- 19 thing.
