EXAMINER BRANCARD: I now call Cases 21565, 22048, Caza Petroleum.

MR. BRUCE: Jim Bruce here on behalf of Caza, Mr. Examiner.

MR. FELDEWERT: May it please the examiner, Michael Feldewert of the Santa Fe office of Holland \& Hart on behalf of Chisholm Energy Holdings.

EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. And I have Advance Energy Partners.

MS. HARDY: Yes, Mr. Examiner. Dana Hardy with the Santa Fe office of Hinkle Shanor on behalf of Advance Energy Partners.

EXAMINER BRANCARD: I think I have COG Operating in 22048.

MS. MUNDS-DRY: Yes. Thank you, Mr. Examiner. Ocean Munds-Dry here for COG Operating, LLC.

EXAMINER BRANCARD: Are there any other interested parties in Cases 21565 or 22048? (Note: Pause.)

Hearing none, Mr. Bruce how would you like to proceed?

MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, just briefly. The first case is a pooling case seeking to pool a portion of the Bone Spring Formation.

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The second case was subsequently filed because that would cause there to be a half section of land, two operators in the same pool, and Caza was seeking an objection.

Now, just very recently the parties have been in contact and they had some good discussions, and we think it would be fruitful just to continue these cases -I forget. Mr. Feldewert mentioned a date and I was agreeable to that -- to let the parties try to work things out voluntarily.

EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
Mr. Feldewert, did you have a date?
MR. FELDEWERT: Yeah, Mr. Brancard. I mean, I think this is one of those circumstances where we need a date just to set, probably, a status conference.

I think what $I$ had suggested was either a month or two, Jim. I can't remember.

MR. BRUCE: I think you had suggested two months, and $I$ was amenable to that.

MR. FELDEWERT: I think that's right. Yeah, I think that makes a lot of sense. I would suggest a status conference two months out, Mr. Brancard.

EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Any other comments from the other parties. Ms. Hardy?

MS. HARDY: No, Mr. Examiner. That's fine with

Advance.

EXAMINER BRANCARD: Ms. Munds-Dry?
MS. MUNDS-DRY: Sounds good to us. Thank you.

EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. What are your dates in October, Marlene?

MS. SALVIDREZ: Give me one second.
MR. FELDEWERT: I'm going to beat you to it,
Marlene. Looks like the 7th and the 21 st, I think.
MS. SALVIDREZ: Yes.
EXAMINER BRANCARD: Why don't we do October 7th?
MR. BRUCE: That's fine with me.
MR. FELDEWERT: That makes sense, Mr. Brancard. Thank you.

EXAMINER BRANCARD: And you're thinking status conference?

MR. FELDEWERT: I am, yes.

MR. BRUCE: Yes.
EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. All right. Then I could just issue a Scheduling Order, then, for this.

Any other comments on Cases 21565, 22048?
(Note: Pause.) Hearing none, these cases will be continued to October 7th. Thank you.
