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Page 4 1 (Time noted 10:43 a.m.) 2 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. Moving on, 3 hopefully a formerly contested group of cases but may be going by affidavit today, but we'll find out. 4 I'll call -47, -48, -49, -50. These are 5 Longfellow in Cases 22020 and 22021 and Spur Energy б 7 Partners Case 22091 and 22092. 8 So let's start with Longfellow. MS. SHAHEEN: Good morning, everyone. Sharon 9 Shaheen on behalf of Longfellow Energy, LP. 10 11 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Are you going ahead with one 12 case by affidavit today, Ms. Shaheen? 13 MS. SHAHEEN: Yes, that's my intent is to go forward with Case 22021. We will be filing a request to 14 15 dismiss Case No. 22020, assuming that Spur is going to 16 inform you as I expect them to. 17 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Well, everybody is waiting for everybody else here. 18 19 So Spur Energy Partners. MR. RANKIN: Good morning, Mr. Examiner. Adam 20 21 Rankin with the law firm of Holland & Hart appearing on behalf of Spur Energy Partners in all four of those cases. 22 23 As indicated in a Prehearing Statement Spur 24 and Longfellow have reached an agreement whereby Spur will 25 dismiss its competing pooling case for the Flintwood well

Page 5 and will dismiss its application to rescind or revoke 1 2 Longfellow's administrative approval of its nonstandard 3 well location on the grounds that Longfellow will, on the 4 record, remove its proposed nonstandard horizontal well location approximately 15 feet to a more standard or 5 orthodox location. б 7 MR. BRANCARD: Okay. So I'm getting that you haven't filed these dismissals yet. 8 MR. RANKIN: I haven't yet. So the agreement 9 was we would confirm on the record that Longfellow was... 10 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. Well, let's look 11 12 for other places here. 13 ConocoPhillips. 14 MR. RODRIGUEZ: Good afternoon. Michael 15 Rodriguez with Hinkle Shanor on behalf of ConocoPhillips 16 Company, and Conoco does not take a position on these 17 matters. 18 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. 19 Are there any other interested persons for Cases 22020, 22021, or 22091 and -92? 20 21 MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, Michael Feldewert with the Santa Fe office of Holland & Hart. 22 23 I have appeared in Case 22021 for SOC 1999 24 Partnership, for SOC GP, LLC. And they have been listed 25 in that case as pooled parties, and I understand the case

Page 6 is going forward today, but Ms. Shaheen has confirmed for 1 2 me that they are no longer parties to be pooled, so with 3 that confirmation, you know, we have nothing further, no 4 further reason to participate in Case 22021. 5 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Is your client a working б interest owner? 7 MR. FELDEWERT: My client is, I understand, an unleased interest owner. 8 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Ms. Shaheen, is that 9 10 correct? MS. SHAHEEN: That's correct. I understand they 11 12 have reached an agreement with SOC, that Longfellow has reached an agreement with SOC, and so they would not be 13 14 force pooling them. 15 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. Anyone else for 16 these cases? (Note: Pause.) 17 Hearing none, Ms. Shaheen you may proceed. MS. SHAHEEN: Thank you. 18 19 In this Application 22021 Longfellow proposes to drill six one-and-a-half-mile wells in the 20 21 Yeso Formation in a standard 480-acre horizontal spacing unit comprised of the south half of Section 19, Township 22 17 South, Range 28 East, and the southeast quarter of 23 24 Section 24, Township 17 South, Range 27 East. And that's 25 in Eddy County. They propose to drill six wells. They're

Page 7 the Bonzo Fed Com 1924CDX wells, and the wells will be 1H 1 2 through 6H. I believe it's the 6H that has the current 3 administrative approval for a nonstandard location, which 4 will be moved inward, that is how I see it, about 15 feet, in accordance with the agreement with Spur. 5 If you turn to the Table of Contents, 6 7 that's helpful for me, in Tab 1 you will find the requisite checklists. 8 Tab 2 is the Application. 9 Tab 3 you will find the Direct Testimony of 10 the landman Mr. Ryan Reynolds, who has previously 11 testified before the Division and had his testimony 12 13 accepted. 14 Then we have the requisite landman exhibits 15 here, A-1 through A-8 and I can talk more specifically 16 about any of those if you would like me to. 17 Exhibit B is the Direct Testimony or the Affidavit of the geologist Jennifer Eker, and attached to 18 her affidavit are the requisite Exhibit, again Exhibits 19 B-1 through B-7. 20 21 Then finally Exhibit C is the Affidavit of 22 Notice which has my affidavit indicating that we sent Notice of the Application to a number of interested 23 24 parties, and the green cards are attached. Some were 25 returned undelivered, but, regardless, in an abundance of

Page 8 caution we did publish to all interested parties, and that 1 2 Affidavit of Publication is attached as an exhibit to 3 Exhibit C. 4 With that, unless there are questions I would ask that the Division accept the exhibit package as 5 a matter of record and take the case under advisement. б 7 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. All right. Mr. Rankin, any questions or 8 9 concerns at this point? MR. RANKIN: Mr. Examiner, thank you. 10 On the statement on the record Longfellow will be moving their 6H 11 12 well approximately 15 feet to a more standard location, we 13 have no objection to the admission of these records or the Division undertaking this case for consideration. 14 15 So I'll just state that we understand that 16 because it's within 15 feet -- rather within 50 feet, the 17 proposed move of this well does not require further approval by the Division, because we are in the variance 18 that's allowed under the Division's regulations. 19 20 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. 21 Mr. Rodriguez, you have no questions or concerns; is that correct? 22 23 MR. RODRIGUEZ: That's correct. Thank you. 24 MR. BRANCARD: Thank you. 25 Mr. Feldewert?

Page 9 1 MR. FELDEWERT: No, sir. 2 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. So Mr. 3 Rose-Coss. 4 EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: Good morning. A point of clarification here. 5 Good morning, Ms. Shaheen. б 7 MS. SHAHEEN: Good morning. EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: Nice to see you again. 8 We are speaking about Case 22021, correct? 9 MS. SHAHEEN: That's right. That's Longfellow's 10 Compulsory Pooling Application. 11 12 EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: Okay. And I'm looking at the exhibits here, and I feel like I heard you mention the 13 Yeso Formation, and in the exhibit here it's talking about 14 15 the Bone Spring. Am I confused about something? 16 Is this a development in the Yeso or --17 MS. SHAHEEN: Are we looking at the Longfellow exhibit package? 18 19 EXAMINER BRANCARD: 22021. 20 MS. SHAHEEN: Let me do a quick search here. 21 EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: That's what I'm looking at. 22 EXAMINER BRANCARD: So is there a particular page of the exhibit that references the Bone Spring? 23 24 EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: I'll try to get back to it. 25 MS. SHAHEEN: I've done a quick search and I'm

Page 10 not finding the Bone Spring, but I would note, though, my 1 2 next case does concern the Bone Spring, so that's why I 3 was just double checking that we are on the same exhibit 4 packet. 5 EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: Okay. I'm scrolling here, and I went back up to the top from the geology section. б 7 Okay? So this is a grouping of cases, Bonzo 8 wells. It's going to Yeso and then Bone Spring and then 9 Wolfcamp, the whole development. 10 MS. SHAHEEN: I am unaware of any Bone Spring 11 12 wells here. So, I mean, I easily could have made a mistake in the exhibit packets, and I'm happy to correct 13 14 that if that is the case. Like I said, I've done a search 15 and --16 EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: You didn't find it. Could 17 probably do that too, here, look for it. (Note: Pause.) 18 Okay. Well, it seems like I was mistaken. I see what I've done. Excuse me. 19 So there were -- it's resolved in my mind 20 21 Thank you. Sorry for any confusion. It piques my now. interest when I hear Yeso because it's a new development 22 area, so I'm trying to look into it. 23 24 But there is no real questions for me, 25 then, if it's clear amongst all of the other parties about

Page 11 what's going on about the compulsory pooling case. 1 2 MS. SHAHEEN: Please let me know if you find a 3 mistake, and I'm happy to correct it right away. 4 EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: No, I was looking in the wrong exhibit packet. I have four open on my screen here. 5 So now I'm in the right one and scrolled through it again. 6 7 That was on my side. But thank you. MS. SHAHEEN: Thank you. 8 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Just to be 9 clear, these are Yeso wells, right? 10 MS. SHAHEEN: That's right. 11 12 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. 13 Any other interested persons for Case 14 22021? (Note: Pause.) 15 Hearing none, we will admit the exhibits here in Case 22021 and take the case under advisement, and 16 17 we will be awaiting dismissals, then, of Cases 22022, 22091 and 22092. Is that correct, Ms. Shaheen? 18 19 MS. SHAHEEN: That is correct. EXAMINER BRANCARD: Is that correct, Mr. Rankin? 20 MR. RANKIN: Correct. We will be filing those 21 22 shortly. 23 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. 24 (Time noted 10:55 a.m.) 25
