- 2 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Let us move on, then, to
- 3 Items 3 through 6.
- This is Cases 22179, 22180, 22181, 22182,
- 5 Devon Energy Production, Sneaky Snake.
- 6 Devon.
- 7 MR. FELDEWERT: May it please the examiner,
- 8 Michael Feldewert with the Santa Fe office of Holland &
- 9 Hart here, appearing on behalf of the Applicant.
- 10 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. Then we have
- 11 Cimarex Energy.
- Good morning, Mr. Examiner. Deana Bennett
- 13 from Modrall Sperling on behalf of Cimarex Energy.
- 14 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. ConocoPhillips.
- 15 MS. MUNDS-DRY: May it please the examiner,
- 16 Ocean Munds-Dry for ConocoPhillips.
- 17 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Are there any other
- 18 interested persons for Cases 22179, -180, -181, -182?
- 19 (Note: Pause.)
- 20 Hearing none, Mr. Feldewert, where are we
- 21 on this?
- 22 MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, on these pooling
- 23 cases we are seeking to pool and create -- seeking to pool
- 24 a spacing unit for three-mile wells, both in the Bone
- 25 Spring and the Wolfcamp Formation underlying the west half

- of Sections 12, 13 and 24 in 23 South, 32 East.
- 2 Cimarex has recently appeared. They have
- 3 objected to the matter proceeding by affidavit. I
- 4 understand that they have proposed wells that overlap in
- 5 Section 12 with the spacing units that Devon seeks to
- 6 create. Section 12 is actually owned by Devon and
- 7 ConocoPhillips.
- I know these wells were proposed by Cimarex
- 9 in July. I am not aware whether they have filed competing
- 10 pooling applications yet or if they intend to do so, but
- 11 given that they have objected to these matters proceeding
- 12 by affidavit we are at the point where we need to schedule
- 13 a hearing.
- 14 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Ms. Bennett, do we have
- 15 competing cases?
- MS. BENNETT: We're in the process of preparing
- 17 the competing applications and will be filing those in the
- 18 very near term. So Mr. Feldewert is correct, those aren't
- 19 yet -- they haven't yet been filed, but we are preparing
- 20 the applications and we will be filing them in the near
- 21 term.
- 22 And so I would suggest that we consider
- 23 setting the cases for a hearing in -- on the January
- 24 continuance docket to allow the parties time to review
- 25 each other's materials, and then have a hearing after the

- 1 parties have attempted to review the applications that
- 2 Cimarex will be filing, and the cases can be consolidated.
- 3 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. And do you have any
- 4 idea when Cimarex might file its competing applications?
- 5 MS. BENNETT: We are drafting them now, so it
- 6 should be soon, but I can't say exactly when.
- 7 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay.
- 8 Ms. Munds-Dry, Conoco.
- 9 MS. MUNDS-DRY: We are here for the ride,
- 10 Mr. Brancard. We are looking forward to seeing which
- 11 party comes out on top. So we are here just staying
- 12 neutral today.
- 13 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right.
- I don't mind setting this for the January
- 15 20th docket. I just sort of need to know what cases we
- 16 need to add on to it.
- 17 So I guess I can wait on the Prehearing
- 18 Order a little bit if you think that's happening soon, Ms.
- 19 Bennett.
- 20 MS. BENNETT: Yes. I'm sorry, Mr. Feldewert.
- 21 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Feldewert.
- MR. FELDEWERT: So I have a couple of
- 23 observations.
- 24 Both these wells were proposed in July.
- 25 They appeared in these cases a week or so ago and

1 contested them moving forward. I don't understand why the

- 2 competing applications weren't filed, you know, at this
- 3 last round for the November docket. I don't see why they
- 4 could not be filed so we could be in a position where we
- 5 could proceed in the December docket.
- I mean, if they are going to object, if
- 7 they are going to propose wells they need to file the
- 8 competing pooling applications so we can get these cases
- 9 moving forward.
- 10 EXAMINER BRANCARD: I would certainly want to
- 11 see these applications filed soon so we can make this sort
- 12 of a cleaner Prehearing Order here, but, Ms. Bennett,
- 13 December, January? How is your client working on this?
- MS. BENNETT: Well, I know that we would prefer
- 15 the January continuance docket date, but I also defer to
- 16 the Division in terms of which docket we end up on. I
- 17 think that either one of the December or the January
- 18 continuance docket dates applications would be filed and
- 19 Notice would have been sent out in time for either the
- 20 December continuance date or the January continuance date.
- 21 It's just a matter of whether the parties will have had a
- 22 chance to review the materials and prepare for the
- 23 hearing.
- 24 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. So just so everybody
- 25 knows, our options basically the nearest dates are

1 December 2nd, which is the first docket, December 16 is

- 2 already booked, January 6th or January 20th.
- 3 MS. BENNETT: With that in mind I would suggest
- 4 either January 6th or January 20 from Cimarex's
- 5 perspective.
- 6 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Feldewert?
- 7 MR. FELDEWERT: We would prefer December 2nd,
- 8 Mr. Brancard.
- 9 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Well --
- 10 MR. FELDEWERT: And I say that, (A) because we
- 11 are the Applicant; (B) because these well proposals have
- 12 been out there since July; and (C) there's no reason why
- 13 we shouldn't be able to accelerate this if and when it's
- 14 available, so that, you know, the parties can move forward
- 15 with their development plans.
- 16 EXAMINER BRANCARD: You know, I'm just a little
- 17 concerned about, you know, other interested parties having
- 18 at least 30-days plus to review the competing proposals
- 19 here. And while I appreciate your concerns, Mr.
- 20 Feldewert, the Commission gets mad at me if I don't have
- 21 all the competing cases heard at the same time.
- MR. FELDEWERT: Well, let me --
- 23 All right. Well, hold on. Let's back up a
- 24 minute.
- 25 They could be filed and they could be heard

1 in timely fashion on the December docket. All of the

- 2 parties have had the competing well proposals in front of
- 3 them since July.
- 4 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Ms. Bennett, have your
- 5 clients sent out competing well proposals already?
- 6 MS. BENNETT: They have, yes.
- 7 EXAMINER BRANCARD: So it's just the filing the
- 8 application for the compulsory pooling that hasn't
- 9 happened?
- 10 MS. BENNETT: That's right.
- 11 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. Let's wing it
- 12 then. December 2nd it is for hearing.
- MS. BENNETT: Thanks.
- 14 And I guess the one thing.
- 15 And Mr. Feldewert may have already
- 16 conferred with Devon about his witnesses, for availability
- 17 for that date. I understand it's set for December 2nd. I
- 18 just need to confer with Cimarex about their availability
- 19 for that date, which I will do promptly.
- 20 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. Let us know if
- 21 there are problems.
- 22 Okay. Are there any other comments or
- 23 concerns about Cases 22179, -180, -181, -182? (Note:
- 24 Pause.)
- 25 Hearing not, these cases will be set or

Page 9 hearing on December 2nd. And I will issue a Prehearing Order and hopefully we will get you, Cimarex will get its applications in so we can do a combined Prehearing Order. If not, I can amend it, I guess. It's just a piece of paper. Thank you. MR. FELDEWERT: Thank you, Mr. Examiner. MS. BENNETT: Thank you. (Time noted 8:30 a.m.)
