- EXAMINER BRANCARD: Next up we have again
- 3 Centennial Resources, Cases 22252 and 22253.
- 4 MS. LUCK: Good morning again, Mr. Examiner.
- 5 Kaitlyn Luck with the Santa Fe office of Holland & Hart
- 6 for the Applicant in these cases, Centennial Resources
- 7 Production Company.
- 8 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. And I have an
- 9 entry of appearance for Atlas OBO Energy.
- 10 MR. COCHRAN: Yes, sir. Good morning, Mr.
- 11 Examiner. This is Joshua Cochran, and I'm with the
- 12 Houston office of Kearney, McWilliams and Davis on behalf
- of Atlas OBO Energy.
- 14 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Are there any
- other interested persons for Cases 22252 or 22253? (Note:
- 16 Pause.)
- 17 Hearing none, okay Ms. Luck. Atlas
- 18 O-B-O -- am I pronouncing that correctly or do you call it
- 19 Oboe?
- 20 MR. COCHRAN: O-b-o, Yes sir.
- 21 EXAMINER BRANCARD: -- has objected to this case
- 22 going forward by, affidavit and Centennial has objected to
- 23 the fact that they are objecting.
- 24 Standard policy is that when somebody files
- 25 an objection to a hearing we have a status conference and

- 1 schedule a hearing.
- 2 Do you have any other points to make today,
- 3 Ms. Luck?
- 4 MS. LUCK: The only two points that I think are
- 5 important to make are that Centennial has a lease
- 6 expiration coming upon April 1st and that's why we would
- 7 like to go ahead and proceed.
- 8 And then also the issue that Atlas is
- 9 raising is a title issue, which is outside the Division's
- 10 jurisdiction, and Centennial's witnesses are here today to
- 11 be cross-examined in terms of any questions that may
- 12 arise, which is why Centennial has asked to proceed at the
- 13 hearing today.
- 14 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 15 So, Mr. Cochran, am I understanding that
- 16 Atlas OBO is not going to be filing competing
- 17 applications, instead you have other issues you need to
- 18 evaluate?
- 19 MS. COCHRAN: Well, I think, uhm, that first
- 20 issue with their competing application is still something
- 21 that we're going to have to get full resolution on with
- 22 the client. Our firm was retained fairly recently.
- 23 Ideally I think that Atlas still believes that an
- 24 agreement can be reached, even with the April of 2022
- 25 lease expiration. What we were looking for was initially

1 just a continuance, maybe a little bit more time to let

- 2 the parties discuss.
- 3 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Are you still of that
- 4 position?
- 5 MR. COCHRAN: As of yesterday and as of this
- 6 morning, from discussions with the client. I have had
- 7 communications with Kaitlyn and Centennial. I don't know
- 8 if it's amenable for both sides but that's our primary
- 9 interest at this point.
- 10 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. Well, why don't
- 11 we set this case for December 2nd. All right? Will that
- 12 work, Ms. Luck?
- MS. LUCK: That works for our office.
- 14 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Cochran?
- 15 MR. COCHRAN: Yes, sir. We'll make that work.
- 16 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 17 And so that's it. Just a reminder. You
- 18 know, folks, our policy on how we handle these cases has
- 19 been written down and up on our website for over a year.
- 20 Somebody files an objection to an affidavit hearing we
- 21 have a status conference. It's in the policy. So it's
- 22 simply the way it works.
- 23 Also, Ms. Luck, I will note that I think
- 24 one of your newspaper publications was a day late in one
- 25 of these cases, so I don't know that we could have gone

- 1 forward anyway today.
- 2 So with that we will set this for a hearing
- 3 on December 2nd.
- 4 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Brancard, Jim Bruce. I'm sorry,
- 5 I had trouble connecting with the Division.
- I simply wanted, in three of these
- 7 Centennial cases, to enter an appearance for Matador
- 8 Production and MRC Permian Company. We are not taking an
- 9 active role in the case.
- 10 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Which of these three cases
- 11 were those?
- 12 MR. BRUCE: 1, 4 and 5, -251 through -253.
- 13 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay.
- MR. BRUCE: Thank you.
- 15 EXAMINER BRANCARD: And you'll file a written
- 16 entry? (Note: No response.)
- 17 Mr. Bruce?
- 18 MR. BRUCE: Yes, I will. Sorry.
- 19 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Sorry you had trouble
- 20 getting in, though. With that we will set Cases 22252 and
- 21 22253 for a hearing on December 2nd, and hopefully the
- 22 parties can work things out beforehand.
- MS. LUCK: Thank you.
- MR. COCHRAN: Thank you, Mr. Examiner.
