- 7 submitted include the Self-Affirmed Declaration of Riley
- 8 Morris who is the landman for Cimarex. He has previously
- 9 testified before the Division and his credentials have
- 10 been accepted as a matter of record.
- 11 In his Declaration he explains the reason
- 12 why Cimarex needs an additional extension of time, which
- 13 is due to Covid and the pandemic, and the past and ongoing
- 14 continued delays that Covid and the disruption in the
- 15 market have caused for folks' Development Plans. So he

- 18 Application we filed on Cimarex's behalf, as well as the
- 19 two Orders that Cimarex is seeking to reopen and amend.
