- 2 series of cases here, 57 through 60, Case 22345, 346, 347,
- 3 348, Matador Production Company.
- 4 MR. RANKIN: Morning, Mr. Hearing Examiner, Adam
- 5 Rankin with the law firm of Holland & Hart, the Santa Fe
- 6 office, appearing on behalf of the applicant in these
- 7 consolidated cases which we which we intend to present by
- 8 affidavit.
- 9 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Are there
- any other interested persons for Cases 22345, 346, 347, 348?
- 11 (No audible response.)
- 12 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, Mr.
- 13 Rankin, you may proceed.
- MR. RANKIN: Thank you, Mr. Hearing Examiner. In
- 15 these four cases Matador is seeking to pool spacing units in
- 16 both the Bone Spring and Wolfcamp formations, in each case
- 17 seeking to pool 240 acre horizontal spacing units.
- 18 Submitted on Tuesday in these cases are exhibit
- 19 packets including the compulsory pooling checklist, the
- 20 applications that were filed in each case, the affidavit of
- 21 Matador's petroleum landman, the affidavit of the geologist,
- 22 and the notice exhibits as well.
- The affidavit of Matador's landman, Exhibit C,
- 24 reviews the specific acreage and pools that Matador is
- 25 seeking to form in each of the proposed spacing units and

1 identifies each of the wells to be dedicated to the four

- 2 spacing units in each case. It includes C-102s for each of
- 3 the wells, identifies the pools that are subject to the, to
- 4 the spacing units.
- 5 Exhibit C-2 identifies the tracts of land that
- 6 comprise each of the proposed spacing units. Exhibit C-3
- 7 identifies each of the working interest owners that Matador
- 8 seeks to pool.
- 9 C-4 contains samples of the well proposal letters
- 10 and AFEs indicating the costs that are anticipated for each
- 11 of the wells and that those costs are commensurate with what
- 12 other operators have incurred to drill similar wells.
- 13 C-5 is a summary of all the contact.
- 14 Matador's geologist, Mr. Andrew Parker, provides
- 15 standard geology exhibits reviewing the target intervals for
- 16 each of the proposed spacing units and wells and does not
- 17 identify any impediments to horizontal development or
- 18 drilling, and testifies that each of the tracts will
- 19 contribute equally to production in the wells.
- 20 Exhibit E and F are the notice affidavits and the
- 21 affidavit of publication reflecting that Matador has
- 22 provided notice to each of the parties it seeks to pool by
- 23 certified mail, as well as providing notice publication
- 24 identifying the parties by name.
- With that, Mr. Examiner, I would move the

1 admission of Exhibits A through F along with the attachments

- 2 and ask that these cases be taken under consideration.
- 3 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 4 Mr. Rose-Coss, any questions?
- 5 TECHNICAL EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: No questions.
- 6 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Mr. Rankin,
- 7 I'm going through your notice provisions here, you seem to
- 8 have mailed this out just on the deadline, November 12, and
- 9 I'm looking at -- this is your Exhibit D, postal service,
- 10 it seems like all of the mail was delivered. Am I reading
- 11 that correctly?
- 12 MR. RANKIN: That is my reading as well. And the
- 13 second point I would make about the notice is that all of
- 14 those parties were identifiable and locatable, so there was
- 15 not any issue we're aware of in terms of who (unclear).
- 16 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Well, there
- 17 seem to be more names on who you gave notice to than who you
- 18 listed as pooled parties, but that's better than the
- 19 opposite.
- 20 All right. You seem to have done your job there.
- 21 Thank you. Are there any other interested persons for cases
- 22 22345, 346, 347 and 348?
