1 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. We will

- 2 call Cases 22176 and 22177, Matador Production Company.
- MS. BROGGI: Mr. Examiner, Julia Broggi with
- 4 Holland & Hart Law Firm on behalf of applicant Matador
- 5 Production Company.
- 6 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you, Ms.
- 7 Broggi. Devon Energy Production?
- 8 MR. SAVAGE: Good morning, Mr. Examiner, Darin
- 9 Savage with Abadie & Schill on behalf of Devon Energy
- 10 Production Company.
- 11 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Do you have any
- 12 objection to those cases going forward by affidavit.
- MR. SAVAGE: No objection.
- 14 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Are there any other
- interested persons for cases 22176 and 22177?
- 16 (No audible response.)
- 17 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, Ms.
- 18 Broggi, you may proceed.
- 19 MS. BROGGI: Mr. Examiner, we would ask to
- 20 consolidate these two cases and present them by affidavit
- 21 and it sounds like Devon doesn't object to it being
- 22 presented by affidavit. Any objection to them being
- 23 presented together?
- 24 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: No problem
- 25 whatsoever. Please proceed.

1 MS. BROGGI: Mr. Examiner, before you you should

- 2 have a packet of exhibits that's includes a table of
- 3 contents. So you will see there that Matador Exhibit A is
- 4 the compulsory pooling checklist. Behind that Exhibit B is
- 5 the compulsory pooling application, and there is one for
- 6 each of the cases.
- 7 And then as you will see in Case Number 22176,
- 8 Matador is seeking to pool all of the uncommitted interest
- 9 in the Bone Spring formation underlying a standard 240 acre
- 10 horizontal spacing unit which is comprised of the N/2 N/2 of
- 11 Section 12 and the N/2 of the NE/4 of Section 11, Township
- 12 21 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.
- 13 And in the companion case, 22177, Matador is
- 14 seeking to pool all the uncommitted interest in the Bone
- 15 Spring formation underlying a standard 240 acre horizontal
- 16 spacing unit. And this time it's the S/2 of the S/2 of the
- 17 N/2 of Section 12, and the S/2 of the NE/4 of Section 11,
- 18 again, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New
- 19 Mexico.
- The next exhibit in the packet is Exhibit C,
- 21 which is an affidavit of landman Nicholas Weeks, with the
- 22 accompanying exhibits which have been identified on the
- 23 table of contents. So we have draft C-102s, the general
- location map, identification of the working interest owners
- 25 that Matador is seeking to pool, as well as identification

1 of the overriding royalty interest owners that Matador is

- 2 seeking to pool, sample well proposal letters and AFEs, and
- 3 then finally a chronology of contacts with the non-joined
- 4 working interest. So that's Exhibit C.
- 5 And then Exhibit D is an affidavit of geologist
- 6 Andrew Tucker that again hopefully Mr. Rose-Coss will be
- 7 find to be a superior geology exhibits. So there we have
- 8 three accompanying exhibits, which is a project location
- 9 map, a subsea structure map, and structural cross section.
- 10 Finally, Exhibit E is the notice of affidavit
- 11 showing that notice of this hearing was provided to the
- 12 parties that Matador is seeking to pool. All the working
- 13 interest owners received notice. Some of the overriding
- 14 royalty interest owners we weren't able to contact, so we
- 15 provided notice of the hearing by publication, and the
- 16 affidavit of that publication is attached as Matador Exhibit
- 17 F.
- 18 At this time I will take any questions, but
- 19 that's the entire packet. So we would be asking the Oil
- 20 Conservation Division to take it under advisement.
- 21 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Mr.
- 22 Savage, any questions?
- MR. SAVAGE: No questions, thank you.
- 24 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Rose-Coss?
- 25 TECHNICAL EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: Yeah, so

1 straightaway, there wasn't any issues with notice on this

- 2 case? You probably mentioned that, but --
- 3 MS. BROGGI: No. All the working interest owners
- 4 received notice. There were a couple -- there are several
- 5 overrides, maybe a couple of letters were returned, so out
- 6 of an abundance we also published notice in the newspaper
- 7 and there is an affidavit of that publication attached as
- 8 Exhibit F.
- 9 TECHNICAL EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: I see that. And
- 10 the thing that strikes me going through the exhibits, the
- 11 wells in this case are running east to west. I'm more
- 12 accustomed to seeing them run north to south. Would you
- 13 know, in this case, is that related to geology or
- 14 engineering perspective that they run that way, or just land
- 15 ownership?
- 16 I suppose there is no protests or complications,
- 17 but I don't see a lot of other wells that -- depicted on the
- 18 image, so is this going to complicate their development in
- 19 the area from east to west?
- 20 MS. BROGGI: Mr. Rose-Coss, I don't know
- 21 personally the justification for it, you know, that the
- 22 geology affidavit, the affidavit from the geologist and
- 23 accompanying exhibits, you know, my understanding from them
- 24 is that they look at the geology there and this makes sense,
- 25 and you know, that there are no problems and geologic

1 impediments to drilling in this direction, but I don't know,

- 2 as I sit here today, the justification for that decision.
- 3 If that's something that the Division needs, you know, we
- 4 can go back and collect that information from them
- 5 separately.
- 6 TECHNICAL EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: I don't believe I
- 7 will ask for anything additional regarding that, it's just
- 8 some comments for the record, unless Mr. Brancard has any
- 9 follow-up to that. And that concludes my questions.
- MS. BROGGI: Thank you.
- 11 TECHNICAL EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: Yes.
- 12 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. My only
- 13 question is, and it's more of a comment, I guess, this
- 14 location seems to be just outside the city of Carlsbad. Is
- 15 that correct, a little bit to the east of Carlsbad? The
- 16 location now, I was just looking at my BLM status map here.
- 17 MS. BROGGI: I apologize. Again, I don't know
- 18 its exact location with respect to Carlsbad. Perhaps I
- 19 should. Let me see.
- 20 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: I think the notice
- 21 said one mile east of Carlsbad.
- 22 MS. BROGGI: Right. But if the notice says that,
- 23 then that would be accurate -- yes, I think that is right.
- 24 Does that present concern?
- 25 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: No, I was just, you

Page 8 know, confirming we are not in any kind of developed area here, but that seems to be what people are doing in Carlsbad these days, drilling right under the city. Thank you. Do we have any other persons interested in cases 22176, 22177? (No audible response.) HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, these cases will be taken under advisement. Thank you, Ms. Broggi. MS. BROGGI: Thank you, Mr. Examiner. (Taken under advisement.)
