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1 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: I think we are on
2 Case 22579, Colgate Operating.

3 MR. DEBRINE: Good morning, Mr. Examiner. Earl
4 Debrine with the Modrall Sperling Firm on behalf of Colgate
5 Operating LLC.

6 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Are there

11 MR. DEBRINE: This case involves an application
12 by Colgate to amend Order R-21590 to extend the time for
13 drilling nunc pro tunc. It was timely filed before the
14 original deadline and the order to commence drilling was
15 expired.

16 We have supported the application with the
17 Exhibit A which is the self-affirmed declaration of the
18 landman Mark Hadjik and also the affidavit of notice of our
19 firm, Jamie Allen. And it requests that notwithstanding the
20 President's Day holiday, that everything was timely, the
21 notice to the parties to the original order. And we also as
22 an abundance of caution published notice of the application,
23 and that was also timely published.

24 We believe that the matters set forth are
25 self-explanatory. The order established horizontal spacing

1 unit, 320 acre Bone Spring horizontal spacing unit in the
2 S/2 of the N/2 of Sections 32 and 31 of Township 19 South,
3 Range 28 East in Eddy County. The two wells are dedicated
4 to the unit of the Bolander 32 State Fed Com 122H and 132H
5 wells. And with that, we will stand for any questions.
