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Page 4 1 (Time noted 10:55 a.m.) 2 EXAMINER BRANCARD: With that I will call Cases 3 22622, 22623, 22624, 22625, Colgate Operating. MS. HARDY: Mr. Examiner, Dana Hardy with Hinkle 4 5 Shanor on behalf of Colgate Operating, LLC. EXAMINER BRANCARD: Any other interested persons б 7 for Cases 22622, -623, -624, -625? (Note: No response.) 8 Hearing none, you may proceed, Ms. Hardy. MS. HARDY Thank you. In Case No. 22622 Colgate 9 seeks an Order pooling all uncommitted interests within 10 the Bone Spring Formation underlying a 240-acre standard 11 12 horizontal spacing unit comprised of the north half/north half of Section 25 and the north half/northeast guarter of 13 Section 26, Township 20 South, Range 28 East in Eddy 14 15 County. Colgate proposes to dedicate the unit to the 16 Boomerang 25 Federal Com 121H and 231H wells. In Case No. 22623, Colgate seeks an Order 17 pooling uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring 18 Formation, again underlying a 240-acre standard spacing 19 unit, and this one is comprised of the south half/north 20 21 half of Section 25 and the south half/northeast quarter of Section 26. That unit will be dedicated to the 22 23 Boomerang 25 Federal Com 122H and 132H wells. 24 In Case 22624 Colgate seeks an Order 25 pooling uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring

Page 5 Formation, again underlying a 240-acre standard spacing 1 2 unit, and this one is comprised of the north half/south 3 half of Section 25 and the north half/southeast quarter of That unit will be dedicated to the Boomerang 4 Section 26. 25 Federal Com 123H and 133H wells. 5 And last but not least, in Case No. 22625 6 7 Colgate seeks an Order pooling uncommitted interests in 8 the Bone Spring Formation underlying a 240-acre standard unit comprised of the south half/south half of Section 25 9 and the south half/southeast quarter of Section 26. 10 That unit will be dedicated to the Boomerang 25 Federal Com 11 12 134H well. 13 In our exhibit packet we provided the Compulsory Pooling Checklist and the affidavits of landman 14 15 Travis Macha and geologist David DaGian. 16 Mr. Macha's exhibits include the standard 17 land exhibits. The land ownership and plat of tracts is provided in Exhibit A-3, and that exhibit also lists the 18 parties who we are seeking to pool, and they are 19 highlighted in yellow. 20 21 We did have one unlocatable party as noted on that exhibit. 22 23 The Hearing Notice information is provided 24 in Exhibit A-6, and we included a chart of the letters 25 that were sent and the dates that they were received, that

1 our Return Notices were received.

2 So I would note that even though several of 3 those Notices, the Certified Mail Notices did not come 4 back to us, Mr. Macha's Exhibit A-5 shows that he had 5 communicated with most of those parties. In fact, I think all of them, other than the one who is unlocatable. б 7 We also did timely Public Notice which is shown in our Affidavit provided in Exhibit A-7. 8 Mr. DaGian provides the standard geology 9 exhibits in each case. There is a Regional Locator Map, a 10 Cross-Section Map, Second and Third Bone Spring Structure 11 12 Maps and Cross-Sections. 13 He also provided a Gunbarrel Development 14 Plan as Exhibit B-7. 15 So with that, unless there are questions I 16 would ask that the exhibits be admitted into the record 17 and that these four cases be taken under advisement. EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Mr. Garcia, 18 19 questions? EXAMINER GARCIA: I guess my questions depend on 20 21 what you ask in your questions, Mr. Brancard. If you 22 don't mind, I guess I'd let you go first. 23 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Put me on the spot 24 here. 25 So Ms. Hardy, I'm confused. Who did the

Page 7 1 Notices? 2 MS. HARDY: So on the Certified Mail Notice to 3 the parties? My office did that. 4 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Right. Then your office also sent the request to the Carlsbad paper? 5 MS. HARDY: Correct. б 7 EXAMINER BRANCARD: The problem here is you're then having your landman in your affidavit saying we did 8 Notice, but he didn't do the Notice, you did the Notice. 9 So what we really need is an affidavit from 10 you or your office of Notice. 11 12 MS. HARDY: Okay. That's fine. This is the way 13 that we've done this in our cases for quite a while and we 14 haven't had an issue, but we're happy to produce an 15 affidavit from our office, as well. 16 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. So in the first case 17 if you go to your Exhibit A-5, which is your Notice 18 Letter. 19 MS. HARDY: Yes. EXAMINER BRANCARD: It indicates you mailed it 20 21 two days ago. 22 MS. HARDY: Oh. That's apparently a typo, and I apologize for that. The letter was printed from the 23 24 electronic version, and it automatically put in the date 25 that it was printed. If you look at the chart on the next

Page 8 page, that shows the dates that we actually sent the 1 2 Notice Letters. 3 I can send a corrected exhibit, if you 4 would like that. 5 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Correct the exhibit. And I think it's just the first case. I think the other cases б 7 are okay but you should check and make sure. 8 MS. HARDY: Yes. Okay. I will do that. EXAMINER GARCIA: Okay. Mr. Garcia. 9 EXAMINER GARCIA: No, you hit on the topics I 10 was thinking you were going to, so I wanted to leave them 11 12 for you. 13 I have no further questions. 14 EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. If you could, 15 then, Ms. Hardy, submit a revised letter, copy of the 16 letter that you sent out, hopefully the original letter. 17 EXAMINER GARCIA: May I, actually? EXAMINER BRANCARD: 18 Yes. 19 EXAMINER GARCIA: J&J Energy, are they an active operator, to your knowledge? It just seems "operator" 20 21 should be easier to get ahold of than "unlocatable". 22 MS. HARDY: Was your question about J&J Energy? You cut out for a minute. 23 EXAMINER GARCIA: Sorry. Do you know if J&J 24 25 Energy is an active operator? It just seems an operator

Page 9 should be able to get ahold of instead of "unlocatable". 1 2 MS. HARDY: I don't believe they are. I can 3 check that, but I think if they were an active operator we would have their contact information. I know that Mr. 4 Macha's Exhibit A-3 states that they attempted delivery at 5 6 two addresses to J&J Energy. 7 So I don't believe they are an active operator, but I will verify that. 8 EXAMINER GARCIA: Thank you. 9 MS. HARDY: Sure. 10 EXAMINER GARCIA: Are there any other interested 11 12 persons here on Cases 22622, -623, -624, -625? (Note: 13 Pause.) 14 Hearing none, the exhibits will be admitted into the record. We will take these cases under 15 16 advisement but we will leave the record open for only a week to submit a new Exhibit A-6 in the first case with a 17 cover affidavit about how you did the Notice. 18 MS. HARDY: I will submit that today, Mr. 19 20 Examiner. Thank you. 21 EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. 22 Is that all we needed, Mr. Garcia? 23 EXAMINER GARCIA: I believe so. 24 (Note: Time noted 11:04 a.m.) 25
