1 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So you wanted to do

- 2 all of the other cases? I have three other Colgate cases,
- 3 do you want to do those together, Ms. Hardy?
- 4 MS. HARDY: Yes, Mr. Examiner.
- 5 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: I will call then
- 6 Cases 22691, 22692, 22695, Colgate Operating.
- 7 MS. HARDY: Dana Hardy on behalf of Colgate
- 8 Operating.
- 9 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Are there
- 10 any other interested parties who entered an appearances in
- 11 Cases 22691, 692 or 695?
- 12 (No audible response.)
- 13 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, Ms.
- 14 Hardy, you may proceed.
- 15 MS. HARDY: Thank you. In Case 22691, Colgate
- 16 seeks an order pooling uncommitted interest in the Bone
- 17 Spring formation from the top of the formation at a depth of
- 18 approximately 4320 feet to a depth of approximately 7673
- 19 feet underlying a 160 acre standard horizontal spacing unit,
- 20 comprised of the N/2 of the S/2 of Section 35, Township 19
- 21 South, Range 28 East. Colgate proposes to dedicate that
- 22 unit to the Uluru 35 Fed State Com 123H. And that unit
- 23 involves a depth severance to address other development in
- 24 the adjacent tracts that are in the Bone Spring Formation.
- In Case 22692, Colgate seeks an order pooling

- 1 uncommitted interest in the Bone Spring Formation underlying
- 2 a 320 acre standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the
- 3 S/2 of the S/2 of Sections 35 and 36, Township 19 South,
- 4 Range 28 East, and proposes to dedicate that unit to the
- 5 Uluru 35 Fed State Com 124H and the Uluru 35 Fed State Com
- 6 134H.
- 7 In in Case 22695, Colgate seeks an order
- 8 approving a 320 acre more or less overlapping spacing unit
- 9 within the Bone Spring Formation to pool all uncommitted
- 10 interest in that unit which is in the Third Bone Spring
- 11 interval from a depth of approximately 7673 feet to the base
- of the formation at a depth of approximately 8820 feet. And
- 13 that unit underlies the N/2 S/2 of Sections 35 and 36,
- 14 Township 19 South, Range 28 East. Colgate proposes to
- 15 dedicate that unit to the Uluru 35 Fed State Com 133H well.
- 16 And that unit partially overlaps with the unit
- 17 that is operated by Mewbourne in Section 36, and so that's
- 18 the reason for the depth severance and the overlapping
- 19 spacing unit request.
- In each case our exhibits include the compulsory
- 21 pooling checklist, the affidavit of the landman Mark Hadjik,
- 22 the affidavit of geologist David DaGian, and my notice
- 23 affidavit.
- Like the prior cases that we discussed,
- 25 Mr. Hadjik's exhibits include the application, C-102s, plat,

1 and ownership interests, well proposals, AFEs, and his

- 2 communication time line.
- 3 The geology exhibits include the regional locator
- 4 map, cross section, location map, structure map, structural
- 5 cross section, stratigraphic cross section and a gunbarrel.
- 6 Exhibit C is again my notice affidavit which
- 7 include the hearing notice letter, a chart of parties to
- 8 whom notices were sent, the certified mail receipts,
- 9 tracking information, and again two affidavits of
- 10 publication. We did publish twice because parties were
- 11 added to the second notice. We did notify the working
- 12 interests, record title owners and overrides as well as
- 13 Mewbourne since they operate the well that overlaps with our
- 14 proposal in Case 22695.
- So with that, unless there are questions, I would
- 16 ask that the cases be taken under advisement and that the
- 17 exhibits be accepted into the record.
- 18 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Mr.
- 19 Rose-Coss?
- 20 TECHNICAL EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: A simple one for
- 21 my edification here again, can you go through again why the
- 22 overlapping spacing unit is being requested?
- 23 MS. HARDY: Sure. It is because -- it's my
- 24 understanding that Mewbourne operates a well that I believe
- 25 is in the Second Bone Spring in Section 36, so this well I

1 think -- in the Third Bone Spring underlies that spacing

- 2 unit, and so this well will run between 35 and 36, so it
- 3 overlaps with Mewbourne's Winchester wells that we have in
- 4 our application reference.
- 5 TECHNICAL EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: So these three
- 6 cases are Third Bone Spring and Wolfcamp, or it's -- which
- 7 Bone Spring and Wolfcamp?
- 8 MS. HARDY: Sure. Okay. So the cases I just
- 9 went through are the three Bone Spring cases, 22691, 22692
- 10 and 22695. And so Case 22691 involves a depth severance
- 11 that is only acreage in Section 35, so there isn't an
- 12 overlapping spacing unit.
- 13 And then in 22692, that is a S/2 S/2 Bone Spring
- 14 unit in Sections 35 and 36. That, because of the acreage,
- 15 does not involve an overlapping unit or a depth severance,
- 16 it's just pooling the entire Bone Spring, the S/2 S/2.
- 17 And then case 22695, that involves the Bone
- 18 Spring, 320 acre unit N/2 S/2 of Sections 35 and 36 that
- 19 involve the depth severance and overlap in Section 36 of
- 20 Mewbourne's well.
- 21 TECHNICAL EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: Okay. But this is
- 22 in the Third Bone Spring, and their well is in the Second
- 23 Bone Spring that is overlapping a little bit?
- MS. HARDY: Correct.
- 25 TECHNICAL EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: And Mewbourne was

1 noticed of this, and if they had a problem they could have

- 2 shown up and spoke to that.
- 3 MS. HARDY: That's correct. And I had contact
- 4 with them, so I know they received the notice.
- 5 TECHNICAL EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: Okay. Well, the
- 6 depth severance, that was addressed and satisfactorily taken
- 7 care of?
- 8 MS. HARDY: That's correct. And we notified all
- 9 of the parties of all of the cases, so the interest owners
- 10 above and below the depth severance knew.
- 11 TECHNICAL EXAMINER ROSE-COSS: Okay. Well, that
- 12 sounds complicated, but like it's also worked out, so thanks
- 13 for explaining that to me. And that's all my questions.
- MS. HARDY: Thank you.
- 15 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So just to go back
- 16 over this again, Mewbourne then in Section 36 has a spacing
- 17 unit that includes the entire Bone Spring?
- 18 MS. HARDY: It's not a pooled spacing unit.
- 19 There was no pooling order. So the well is a, it's a Second
- 20 Bone Spring well.
- 21 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: It would have
- 22 designated a pool.
- MS. HARDY: That's correct. So I think that's
- 24 the reason for the overlapping notice and request.
- 25 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. So their

Page 8 Second Bone Spring, your Second Bone Spring well doesn't 1 2. cover their section, and your Third Bone Spring well does cover their section? 3 MS. HARDY: Exactly. HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Thank you. 5 6 MS. HARDY: Thank you. 7 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Are there any other 8 interested persons in cases 22691, 692, 695? 9 (No audible response.) 10 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, the exhibits will be admitted into the record and cases will be 11 12 taken under advisement. MS. HARDY: Thank you. 13 14 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: I will just check here with the court reporter. We are an hour in. Are you 15 doing okay? Do you need a break? 16 17 REPORTER: I'm doing fine. You can keep going if you'd like. 18 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right.
