1 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: We will move on

- 2 to Case 22819.
- 3 Are there any other interested persons
- 4 here for Case 22819?
- 5 Hearing none, Mr. Smith you may move
- 6 forward.
- 7 MR. SMITH: Thank you, Mr. Examiner.
- 8 Again, Bryce Smith with Modrall Sperling
- 9 on behalf of the applicant Franklin Mountain Energy,
- 10 LLC. As previously mentioned this is a companion
- 11 case to active Bone Spring and Wolfcamp orders in
- 12 the same acreage.
- In this case, 22189, Franklin is seeking
- 14 an order from the Division pooling all committed
- 15 mineral interests in a 360-acre Leonard horizontal
- 16 spacing unit underlying the east half of the west
- 17 half of Sections 1 and 12 and then the northeast
- 18 quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 13,
- 19 Township 26 South, Range 35 East, Lea County.
- 20 Franklin timely filed its affidavit on
- 21 May 31st and Tab A is the compulsory pooling
- 22 checklist.
- 23 Along with that is Tab B which is the
- 24 declaration of expert professional landman Ilona
- 25 Hoang and as a few moments ago, her credentials were

- 1 accepted as a matter of record.
- 2 Behind her declaration you will find the
- 3 applications and C102s for the well. You'll also
- 4 find the lease tract map, summary of interest and
- 5 the parties to be pooled.
- 6 Again, with this case, Franklin recently
- 7 entered into a voluntary agreement with COG
- 8 Operating, LLC. So we'll be submitting an updated
- 9 Exhibit B4 to reflect that.
- 10 Included with the exhibits is -- the
- 11 landman exhibits is the summary of contacts with the
- 12 working interest owner as well as a sample of the
- 13 well proposal letter and the AFEs.
- 14 Lastly is a notice affidavit prepared by
- 15 this firm which shows notice was timely mailed on
- 16 May 12, 2022. And out of an abundance of caution,
- 17 we also published in the newspaper on May 15 and the
- 18 affidavit from -- the newspaper affidavit of
- 19 publication is included as well.
- 20 Lastly in the exhibit packet is Tab C,
- 21 which is the declaration of expert petroleum
- 22 geologist Ben Kessel. Mr. Kessel has previously
- 23 testified before the Division and his credentials
- 24 have been accepted as a matter of record.
- 25 With Mr. Kessel's declaration is the

1 typical suite of geology exhibits including the

- 2 locator map, the well bore schematic, the geology
- 3 study of the well and the optimal stress orientation
- 4 showing that north-south is the optimal orientation
- 5 of the area.
- 6 With that, Mr. Examiner, I would stand for
- 7 questions and ask that exhibits in Case Number 22819
- 8 be admitted into the record and that the case be
- 9 taken under advisement.
- 10 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 11 Mr. Garcia, any questions?
- 12 TECHNICAL HEARING OFFICER GARCIA: One
- 13 question. Is there any stranded acreage south of
- 14 this proposed unit, because it only takes up 40
- 15 acres of the south section.
- MR. SMITH: Mr. Garcia, I don't -- I'm not
- 17 aware of whether there is stranded acreage in the --
- 18 south of this proposed spacing unit. But we can
- 19 follow-up with the Division on that after we talk to
- 20 Franklin, but I would just mention that there is the
- 21 companion cases with the exact same spacing unit in
- the Bone Spring and Wolfcamp, which have been
- 23 improved in this area.
- 24 TECHNICAL HEARING OFFICER GARCIA: Please
- 25 follow-up, though, still.

Page 6 1 MR. SMITH: Yes, Mr. Garcia. 2 TECHNICAL HEARING OFFICER GARCIA: No 3 other questions. 4 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Thank you. Mr. Smith, do you any idea why 819 and 820 5 are different shapes, lengths than 818, 821? 6 7 MR. SMITH: Mr. Examiner, I believe it's just to capture Franklin's acreage down in that 9 southern part of their ownership in that area. Ιt 10 is part of the greater development plan, as I 11 mentioned, with the Wolfcamp and the Bone Spring 12 units. 13 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay. Thank 14 you.
