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1 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: We will call

- 2 Case Numbers 22674, 22675.
- 3 MR. BRUCE: Jim Bruce for Mewbourne.
- 4 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 5 Are there any other interested persons for
- 6 Cases 22674, 22675?
- 7 Hearing none, Mr. Bruce, you may proceed.
- 8 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, looking at
- 9 Exhibit 1, which contains both applications and the
- 10 proposed notices -674, Mewbourne seeks to -- it's
- 11 kind of a mirror image of the last case we just
- 12 discussed except as to the Brine well.
- Mewbourne seeks to pool the north
- 14 half-north half of Section 31, 24 South, 29 East as
- 15 to the Bone Spring formation for one of its Prince
- 16 Bone Spring wells.
- 17 Case -675 seeks to force pool the south
- 18 half-north half of Section 31 for another Prince
- 19 Bone Spring well.
- 20 Exhibit 2 is the landman's affidavit.
- 21 Again, there is only -- the only person
- 22 sought to be pooled is Chevron USA, Inc., is the
- 23 record title owner of a State lease covering a
- 24 portion of the north half of Section 31, and I will
- 25 get you a tract map so you can determine where that

1 is. I think I might actually have something in my

- 2 file. Actually there is a tract map by the landman
- 3 but I needed to clarify with him, I believe when you
- 4 look at the landman's Attachment A, you will see
- 5 these tracts maps. I believe that Chevron is the
- 6 direct or title owner of State Lease VB-54, V as in
- 7 victory, B as in boy, 54. I will confirm that with
- 8 the landman, but at least you can see what acreage
- 9 Chevron owns.
- 10 Again, Mewbourne has contacted Chevron
- 11 requesting them to sign the Com agreement. Chevron
- 12 has, you'll see there are some -- also some emails
- 13 between the parties. Chevron has just never
- 14 bothered to sign the Com agreements for these wells,
- 15 and therefore Mewbourne seeks to pool them so that
- 16 not only the State Land Office but since there is
- 17 Federal land in the well unit, the BLM will approve
- 18 the Com agreements for the wells so that Mewbourne
- 19 is authorized to produce the wells.
- 20 And Exhibit 3 is my notice affidavit.
- 21 Chevron was given written notice and it did receive
- 22 the certified mail. And once I knew that address
- 23 was valid, I did not publish notice.
- 24 Exhibit 4 contains the pooling checklists
- 25 for both the wells. And I would move the exhibits

1 the admission of Exhibits 1 through 4 and ask that

- 2 these matters be taken under advisement.
- 3 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay.
- 4 MR. BRUCE: I can always get geological
- 5 affidavit and exhibits if you need to.
- 6 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay.
- 7 Mr. Rose-Coss?
- 8 MR. ROSE-COSS: I suppose I would hand it
- 9 to you, Mr. Brancard, and agree that a tract map
- 10 would be helpful just in order to confirm. I can
- 11 see on Page 18 that there are tract maps, but, you
- 12 know, just to confirm that, you know, the ownership
- 13 of those tracts and what's in the area. That would
- 14 be helpful.
- MR. BRUCE: I will get that done.
- MR. ROSE-COSS: Okay. With that, that's
- 17 the rest of my questions. I suppose it's hard to,
- 18 yeah, verify other information, just taking your
- 19 word here, without at least a tract map. Everything
- 20 else in here is here. Thank you.
- 21 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 22 Are there any other interested persons for
- 23 Cases 22674, 22675?
- Hearing none, the exhibits in Cases 22674
- 25 and -675 will be taken under advisement with the

1 submission of a tract map and also just with the

- 2 caveat that we're still thinking about the issue of
- 3 the geologic exhibits.
- 4 MR. BRUCE: Sure.
- 5 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: I mean, if you
- 6 want to avoid the problem you can just kind of
- 7 submit them so we don't to have to dock you a month
- 8 from now saying --
- 9 MR. BRUCE: I will do that. Like I said,
- 10 I'm the main culprit in these late filed exhibits.
- 11 I've had a rather busy four or five days, but I will
- 12 go ahead and get them and then if either you or
- 13 Mr. Rose-Coss has any questions, you can e-mail me
- 14 and we can clear that up. But I will get the
- 15 geology just so you have it.
- 16 HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Thank you.
- 17 Appreciate that. Thank you.
- 18 So cases 22674 and 22675 are taken under
- 19 advisement.
