OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION'S MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING TO NOVEMBER 9, 2022

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("OCD") moves to reschedule the continue the hearing in this matter to November 9, 2022, and states the following in support thereof:

1. On September 29, 2020, OCD docketed the Notice of Violation issued to M&M Production and Operation ("M&M") and served the docketing notice on M&M by first class and electronic mail.

2. OCD in the docketing notice stated that the informal resolution period had expired without resolution of the NOV.

3. Shortly after OCD served the docketing notice, M&M's owner contacted OCD's counsel to advise that she had been in the hospital and was just recently released and is still recovering from a serious illness. M&M's owner requested additional time to review the NOV and discuss an informal resolution with OCD.

4. On September 30, 2022, OCD moved to continue the hearing in this matter indefinitely to allow the parties to attempt to reach an informal resolution within a reasonable period of time.

5. At this time, OCD is requesting to continue the hearing date to November 9, 2022 to provide notice to M&M.
