1 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Let's try to get the  
2 last one done here then. I hope you are still okay,  
3 Mr. Baca.

4 MR. BACA: We are okay.

5 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: And this would be  
6 case number 22899, Enduring Resources.

7 MR. RANKIN: Mr. Examiner, good afternoon, Adam  
8 Rankin appearing on behalf of the applicant in this case,  
9 Enduring Resources with the Santa Fe office of Holland &  
10 Hart.

11 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. You are okay,  
12 Mr. Rankin? Your voice seems a little scratchy today.

13 MR. RANKIN: I am recovering from whatever took  
14 me out, and I'm working my way back.

15 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. Are there  
16 any other interested persons for case 22899?

17 (No audible response.)

18 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, please  
19 proceed, Mr. Rankin.

20 MR. RANKIN: Thank you, Mr. Examiner. This is a  
21 case in which the applicant, Enduring Resources, is seeking,  
22 at the behest of the district office, to contract pools that  
23 are located within its proposed voluntary unit, the proposed  
24 Haynes Canyon Unit, that was heard by the Division  
25 previously at hearing, and to expand the Counselors

1 Gallup-Dakota pool to the interior boundary of the proposed  
2 Haynes Canyon unit area.

3 We filed on Tuesday a set of exhibits that  
4 reflects the applicant's request, Exhibits A through D.

5 Exhibit A is a copy of the application that was  
6 filed with the case which reviews the unit area that is  
7 proposed and was subject to case number 22854 which was  
8 presented to the Division on June 2.

9 The application identifies the unit area and the  
10 request to contract pools from outside of that unit area and  
11 to expand the Counselors Gallup-Dakota pool, which is the  
12 pool that was identified by the district office. They would  
13 like to have the assigned pool for the unit area.

14 Exhibit B is the self-affirmed statement of  
15 Enduring's landman. This is a Anita Ashland, and she has  
16 previously testified before the Division and she is the  
17 landman that's responsible for the formation in the proposed  
18 unit and testified at the June 2nd hearing throughout the  
19 day.

20 Enduring, she reflects, requested an order that  
21 would contract, in this case, the Basin Mancos Pool, which  
22 is pool code 97232 from outside of the proposed unit area  
23 which is reflected in her self-affirmed statement, and to  
24 expand the Counselors Gallup-Dakota pool, which is pool code  
25 13379, to the interior boundary of the proposed Haynes

1 Canyon unit area so there would be only one designated pool  
2 within the unit area that would be applicable to the  
3 unitized formation.

4 Attached to her self-affirmed statement is a  
5 general location map that just kind orients the Division to  
6 the area of the unit.

7 Unit B-2 is a plat that depicts the unit acreage  
8 in the area as part of the proposed unit agreement. That  
9 plat identifies the unit boundary in the area within which  
10 the Counselors pool would be expanded to that unit boundary.

11 The purpose for doing so is, number one, Enduring  
12 was requested to bring this application by the district  
13 office to effect this pool change, number one. Number two,  
14 so that there would be only one pool in the unit area which  
15 would accommodate administrative efficiency so that we don't  
16 have more than one pool assigned to wells within the unit  
17 area.

18 Exhibit C is a copy of the affidavit prepared by  
19 me giving notice to affected parties within one mile of the  
20 unit boundary to let them know that Enduring is proposing a  
21 change to the unit -- rather the pool, pools designated  
22 within the unit area.

23 Exhibit D is a copy of the -- sorry -- within  
24 that affidavit you will see a copy of the letter that was  
25 sent out to the affected parties, as well as a list of the

1 status of the certified letters that went out to each of  
2 those parties.

3 We did send out a supplemental notice to the  
4 parties to make sure everyone within that one mile area did  
5 get notice, and that's why there are two letters with  
6 different dates.

7 Finally in Exhibit D is a copy of an affidavit of  
8 publication reflecting that we gave notice as well of this  
9 application hearing in the Rio Grande Sun which is the  
10 county within which the unit is located.

11 With that, Mr. Examiner, I think we would ask  
12 that the case be taken under advisement and that Exhibits A  
13 through D and their attachments be accepted into the record.  
14 I'm happy to try to address any questions that the Division  
15 may have.

16 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.  
17 Mr. Garcia, questions?

18 TECHNICAL EXAMINER GARCIA: I'm assuming because  
19 it's units, there is no wells in this acreage, is there?

20 MR. RANKIN: I believe that's true, although I  
21 don't know 100 percent. Ms. Ashland is on. There may be  
22 some APDs that were filed. She and I talked a little bit  
23 about this and I do have her here to address that issue.

24 So with that, I may ask her, if she is available,  
25 to answer that question for you, Mr. Garcia.

1           TECHNICAL EXAMINER GARCIA: The reason I ask is  
2 that, you know, basically when we change pools around  
3 existing wells in that pool, we have to make sure, can  
4 district offices move the operators, and obviously you did  
5 all the paperwork for this hearing, that's why I'm asking.

6           MR. RANKIN: Yeah, my understanding is that, you  
7 know, because it's limited to the unit area, I believe  
8 Enduring was the only operator impacted. But Ms. Ashland is  
9 on, and she may be able to answer the question whether or  
10 not there are wells that require, you know, changing the  
11 pool designation.

12           TECHNICAL EXAMINER GARCIA: If we don't mind, I  
13 guess, Mr. Brancard, just so I can make sure the district  
14 office stays included with any change of plans they have to  
15 do for other wells or operators if needed.

16           HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Ms. Ashland, are you  
17 available.

18           MS. ASHLAND: Yes, I am.

19           HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Raise your right  
20 hand. Do you solemnly swear the testimony you are about to  
21 give is the truth and nothing but the truth?

22           MS. ASHLAND: Yes, I do.

23           HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Please identify  
24 yourself and your position.

25           MS. ASHLAND: My name is Anita Ashland. I'm the

1 senior landman with Enduring Resources LLC.

2 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Did you understand  
3 the question from Mr. Garcia?

4 MS. ASHLAND: I did. There are no other wells in  
5 the Mancos formation within the boundaries of the unit.

6 TECHNICAL EXAMINER GARCIA: Okay. That makes  
7 life a lot easier. We can go on through and we'll get back  
8 to you. And I think just logical questions covering the  
9 unit, we are only expanding it? We are not taking away from  
10 any other sections of that pool, we're just expanding it to  
11 cover the unit?

12 MS. ASHLAND: That's correct.

13 TECHNICAL EXAMINER GARCIA: I believe that's all  
14 my questions, Mr. Brancard.

15 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Are both  
16 of these pools in the unit right now, proposed unit?

17 MS. ASHLAND: Yes, they, they both cover portions  
18 of the unit.

19 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay, thank you. And  
20 I did have a question for you, Mr. Rankin. Are you aware of  
21 Division orders that establish these -- the outlines of  
22 these pools? In other words, we need to amend the existing  
23 Division orders to do this.

24 MR. RANKIN: I -- let me think about that. I  
25 don't believe I have. I haven't fully researched it.



1 Fortunately I'm not a keeper of the pools or the boundaries,  
2 so I don't know.

3 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD? We can look it up, I  
4 was just hoping you did the work.

5 MR. RANKIN: I don't know the answer to the  
6 question, Mr. Examiner, but I imagine there probably are  
7 nomenclature orders, I suppose, although I know sometimes  
8 the Division has done it without hearing orders, so I don't  
9 know for certain off the top of my head.

10 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. So just, I  
11 mean, just for the record then, in coming up with an order  
12 we may come up with an order that's an amendment to an  
13 existing pool order, or two existing pool orders for two  
14 pools.

15 MR. RANKIN: I understand that. That would make  
16 sense if those orders exist.

17 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Just so you are  
18 clear, that's where we may go with this. And I assume this  
19 is sort of a package that goes with our blessing for your  
20 unit, for the Haynes Canyon Unit?

21 MR. RANKIN: Yeah, we understand that we are  
22 requesting they be separate applications for approval of the  
23 unit, number one, and then separately, file a separate  
24 application to address the pools.

25 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. But hopefully

1 we will issue that all in together. All right.

2 MR. RANKIN: That would make sense.

3 TECHNICAL EXAMINER GARCIA: Mr. Brancard, the  
4 pool, it would be preferable to keep the pool expansion  
5 separate, because other operators have the ability to expand  
6 the pool, too. (Unclear audio.)

7 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: I agree, I think  
8 there will be separate orders, I'm just trying to get them  
9 out at the same time.

10 TECHNICAL EXAMINER GARCIA: Okay. Making sure.  
11 You scared me.

12 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Anything else,  
13 Mr. Rankin?

14 MR. RANKIN: No, I don't think so. I appreciate  
15 the consideration, and yeah, appreciate the attention to the  
16 orders so that Enduring can proceed.

17 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. And you  
18 know, we have people who know more about units who will be  
19 working on the orders, so they may reach out and ask, ask  
20 some questions.

21 MR. RANKIN: Yeah, if anything comes up, we are  
22 happy to address it.

23 HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: With that, anybody  
24 else who has comment on case 22899?

25 (No audible response.)
