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1	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. Item
2	number 33, case 22924, Invito Operating.
3	MS. HARDY: Yes, Mr. Examiner, Dana Hardy with
4	Hinkle Shanor on behalf of Invito Operating.
5	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Are there any other
6	persons or here for case 22924?
7	(No audible response.)
8	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, Ms.
9	Hardy, you may proceed.
10	MS. HARDY: Thank you, in this case Invito seeks
11	an order pooling all uncommitted interest in the San Andres
12	Formation underlying a 160 acre, more or less, standard
13	horizontal spacing unit comprised of Lot 1, SE/4 of the NE/4
14	and the E/2 of the SE/4, so that's the E/2 E/2 equivalent of
15	Section 1, Township 9 South, Range 33 East in Lea County,
16	and the unit will be dedicated to the Palisade Number 1H
17	Well.
18	We have provided with our exhibit packet the
19	supplemental statement of landman Jarod Poteet. He provides
20	the standard land exhibits, C-102, the plot of tracts and
21	ownership interests, the sample well proposal letter and AFE
22	and the chronology of contacts.
23	The tract ownership information and the pooled
24	parties are identified in Exhibit A-3, and we did have a
25	unlocatable interests. They are indicated by asterisks, and

1	Mr. Poteet's chronology of contacts, A-5, discusses the
2	efforts that were made to locate those unlocatable parties.
3	And Mr. Poteet has not previously testified before the
4	Division, and we did provide his qualifications.
5	Exhibit B is the self-affirmed statement of
6	geologist Candice Carrell. Ms. Carrell has not previously
7	testified, and we provided her resume.
8	She also provides the standard geology exhibits,
9	a regional location map, a Pi marker structure map and a
10	stratigraphic cross section.
11	Exhibit C is my self-affirmed statement on
12	notice, provided a sample notice letter, the chart of notice
13	that shows interested parties and (unclear audio) and we
14	also did timely publish for this case on July 15 of 2022,
15	and we provided the affidavit of publication.
16	So with that, unless there are questions, I
17	request the exhibits be accepted and the case be taken under
18	advisement.
19	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
20	Mr. Garcia?
21	TECHNICAL EXAMINER GARCIA: Are you compulsory
22	pooling only mineral interest owners, or is there other
23	interests?
24	MS. HARDY: I think they are primarily unleased
25	mineral interest owners.

1	TECHNICAL EXAMINER GARCIA: I'm trying to
2	remember, are (unclear audio) needed for mineral interest
3	owners only?
4	MS. HARDY: I believe it's that they that they
5	are. I think it was rights that we are not pooling.
6	TECHNICAL EXAMINER GARCIA: Okay. Yeah, I'm fine
7	with that. I have no other questions than that,
8	Mr. Brancard.
9	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. There is whole
	lot of people you are trying to pool here.

11	MS. HARDY: A lot of very small interests in this
12	area.
13	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Which means we
L 4	expect you to do more. So who did you who is actually
15	being pooled here?
16	MS. HARDY: If you look at look at actually a
L 7	couple of places. If you look at Page on Page 12 of the
18	PDF.
19	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay.
20	MS. HARDY: It lists the parties, and it
21	continues for several pages. We list the parties with
22	interest in each tract, the percentage of the interest and
23	whether they are being pooled. And it also identifies
24	whether they are unlocatable. Most of them are locatable,
25	but there are some unlocatable.

1	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Tract 1 and 2, 3,
2	there is no cumulative.
3	MS. HARDY: The cumulative information is on
4	Page 11.
5	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. So if we took
6	this list, and then we took it to I think it's on Page 22
7	where you sent out notice to people, that should correlate?
8	MS. HARDY: It should.
9	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: And it includes like
10	the unlocatable parties in the list here that notices were
11	sent out to?
12	MS. HARDY: It does if they were addressed to
13	them. They were all listed in the publication notice. We
14	would send notice to everyone we had addresses for, and then
15	only if there were no address available (unclear audio).
16	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So you have all of
17	these estates here, and you are claiming that there is no
18	addresses for them?
19	MS. HARDY: I believe we would have sent notices
20	to the address located. Look at the green cards.
21	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: I am looking at Page
22	21, there is a whole list, there is like five estates in a
23	row that says, "no address found." In other words, you
24	didn't even send you didn't send it says, "No letter
25	sent."

1	MS. HARDY: Okay. I'm I'm sorry, which
2	are you looking at?
3	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: I'm on Page 21 of the
4	PDF.
5	MS. HARDY: Okay. So those those are the
6	landman's efforts to contact and locate parties, so that
7	would be correct. And she discussed on Page Page 19,
8	what she had done to try to locate parties.
9	I think this is an area where the land ownership
10	has been very fragmented and complicated, so I think it's
11	difficult and not possible to track down everyone. They use
12	(unclear audio) to try to locate people with land brokers,
13	there was a lot of work done to try to locate all of the
14	owners.
15	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So it says, "Searched
16	obituaries to identify possible heirs." So I would guess
17	that these so I guess I just like some more information
18	where you are not sending letters out to people as to how
19	you came to that conclusion. In other words, have you sent
20	AFEs to addresses before and there was nobody there, and you
21	tried to contact heirs and no one responded, and so you
22	finally just broke her hand. But totally you will have done
23	enough due diligence to be able to justify the fact that no
24	letter was sent at all.
25	MS. HARDY: Okay. We can provide a supplemental

1	affidavit from the landman.				
2	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: And of course it also				
3	seems, you know, often in these cases you have people that				
4	are related to each other. So if you talk to one person,				
5	perhaps then they tell you about someone else.				
6	MS. HARDY: That is possible.				
7	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: They are related to				
8	somebody on the list.				
9	MS. HARDY: That's right. I think (unclear				
L O	audio) routinely.				
11	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So, anyway, I mean,				
12	as you're aware, we are getting challenges to whether proper				
13	notice has been given and whether people really were				
L 4	unlocatable, and we are getting people coming back a year				
15	later challenging orders, so we need to have these things				
16	documented. And, you know, in one case you have one tract				
L 7	at 17.5 percent unreachable party. That's quite a decent				
18	percentage there.				
19	Okay. I think that was only questions I had, so				
20	if you could just try to provide a little more information				
21	about people you were unable to locate and what efforts				
22	specifically to arrive at that conclusion.				
23	MS. HARDY: Sure, we would be happy to do that,				
24	Mr. Examiner.				
25	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Garcia, do you				

1	have any follow-up?				
2	TECHNICAL EXAMINER GARCIA: I have no further				
3	questions.				
4	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. Once				
5	again, any other persons for case 22924?				
6	(No audible response.)				
7	HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, the				
8	exhibits will be admitted into the record and the case will				
9	be taken under advisement, but there will be additional				
10	information on unlocatable parties.				
11	MS. HARDY: Thank you, Mr. Examiner.
