


HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: All right. Item number 33, case 22924, Invito Operating.

MS. HARDY: Yes, Mr. Examiner, Dana Hardy with Hinkle Shanor on behalf of Invito Operating.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Are there any other persons or here for case 22924?
(No audible response.)

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, Ms. Hardy, you may proceed.

MS. HARDY: Thank you, in this case Invito seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interest in the San Andres Formation underlying a 160 acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of Lot 1 , SE/4 of the NE/4 and the E/2 of the $S E / 4$, so that's the E/2 E/2 equivalent of Section 1, Township 9 South, Range 33 East in Lea County, and the unit will be dedicated to the Palisade Number 1H Well.

We have provided with our exhibit packet the supplemental statement of landman Jarod Poteet. He provides the standard land exhibits, $C-102$, the plot of tracts and ownership interests, the sample well proposal letter and AFE and the chronology of contacts.

The tract ownership information and the pooled parties are identified in Exhibit $A-3$, and we did have a unlocatable interests. They are indicated by asterisks, and

Mr. Poteet's chronology of contacts, $A-5$, discusses the efforts that were made to locate those unlocatable parties. And Mr. Poteet has not previously testified before the Division, and we did provide his qualifications.

Exhibit B is the self-affirmed statement of geologist Candice Carrell. Ms. Carrell has not previously testified, and we provided her resume.

She also provides the standard geology exhibits, a regional location map, a Pi marker structure map and a stratigraphic cross section.

Exhibit $C$ is my self-affirmed statement on notice, provided a sample notice letter, the chart of notice that shows interested parties and (unclear audio) and we also did timely publish for this case on July 15 of 2022, and we provided the affidavit of publication.

So with that, unless there are questions, I request the exhibits be accepted and the case be taken under advisement.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.

Mr. Garcia?

TECHNICAL EXAMINER GARCIA: Are you compulsory pooling only mineral interest owners, or is there other interests?

MS. HARDY: I think they are primarily unleased mineral interest owners.

TECHNICAL EXAMINER GARCIA: I'm trying to remember, are (unclear audio) needed for mineral interest owners only?

MS. HARDY: I believe it's that they -- that they are. I think it was rights that we are not pooling.

TECHNICAL EXAMINER GARCIA: Okay. Yeah, I'm fine with that. I have no other questions than that, Mr. Brancard.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. There is whole lot of people you are trying to pool here.

MS. HARDY: A lot of very small interests in this area.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. Which means we expect you to do more. So who did you -- who is actually being pooled here?

MS. HARDY: If you look at -- look at actually a couple of places. If you look at Page -- on Page 12 of the PDF.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay.
MS. HARDY: It lists the parties, and it continues for several pages. We list the parties with interest in each tract, the percentage of the interest and whether they are being pooled. And it also identifies whether they are unlocatable. Most of them are locatable, but there are some unlocatable.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Tract 1 and 2, 3, there is no cumulative.

MS. HARDY: The cumulative information is on
Page 11.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. So if we took this list, and then we took it to -- I think it's on Page 22 where you sent out notice to people, that should correlate?

MS. HARDY: It should.
HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: And it includes like the unlocatable parties in the list here that notices were sent out to?

MS. HARDY: It does if they were addressed to them. They were all listed in the publication notice. We would send notice to everyone we had addresses for, and then only if there were no address available (unclear audio).

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So you have all of these estates here, and you are claiming that there is no addresses for them?

MS. HARDY: I believe we would have sent notices to the address located. Look at the green cards.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: I am looking at Page 21, there is a whole list, there is like five estates in a row that says, "no address found." In other words, you didn't even send -- you didn't send -- it says, "No letter sent."

MS. HARDY: Okay. I'm -- I'm sorry, which -are you looking at?

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: I'm on Page 21 of the PDF.

MS. HARDY: Okay. So those -- those are the landman's efforts to contact and locate parties, so that would be correct. And she discussed on Page -- Page 19, what she had done to try to locate parties.

I think this is an area where the land ownership has been very fragmented and complicated, so I think it's difficult and not possible to track down everyone. They use (unclear audio) to try to locate people with land brokers, there was a lot of work done to try to locate all of the owners.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So it says, "Searched obituaries to identify possible heirs." So I would guess that these -- so I guess I just like some more information where you are not sending letters out to people as to how you came to that conclusion. In other words, have you sent AFEs to addresses before and there was nobody there, and you tried to contact heirs and no one responded, and so you finally just broke her hand. But totally you will have done enough due diligence to be able to justify the fact that no letter was sent at all.

MS. HARDY: Okay. We can provide a supplemental
affidavit from the landman.
HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: And of course it also seems, you know, often in these cases you have people that are related to each other. So if you talk to one person, perhaps then they tell you about someone else.

MS. HARDY: That is possible.
HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: They are related to somebody on the list.

MS. HARDY: That's right. I think (unclear audio) routinely.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So, anyway, I mean, as you're aware, we are getting challenges to whether proper notice has been given and whether people really were unlocatable, and we are getting people coming back a year later challenging orders, so we need to have these things documented. And, you know, in one case you have one tract at 17.5 percent unreachable party. That's quite a decent percentage there.

Okay. I think that was only questions I had, so if you could just try to provide a little more information about people you were unable to locate and what efforts specifically to arrive at that conclusion.

MS. HARDY: Sure, we would be happy to do that, Mr. Examiner.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Mr. Garcia, do you
