HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: We got a thumbs up from Mr. Baca, okay. Thank you. So with that, we are back on the record. New Mexico Oil Conservation Division hearings, August 4, 2022. I believe we are on Items 34 and 35, case 22926, 22927, COG Operating.

MS. McLEAN: Good morning, Jaclyn McLean of Hinkle Shanor on behalf of COG Operating.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you. Are there any other appearances in cases 22926 and 22927?
(No audible response.)
HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, Ms. McLean, you may proceed.

MS. McLEAN: Thank you. In case 22926 and 22927 , COG seeks to pool all uncommitted interests within the Bone Spring formation in the $E / 2$ and $W / 2$ of Sections 10 and 5, Township 22 South, Range 34 East in Lea County, New Mexico.

In case 22926, COG has applied for an order pooling all uncommitted interest within the Ojo Chiso Bone Spring Pool underlying a 640 acre standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2 of Section 15, Township 22 South, Range 34 East in Lea County. And that unit will be dedicated to the Yeah Yeah Federal Com Number 501H, 502H, $503 \mathrm{H}, 601 \mathrm{H}, 605 \mathrm{H}$ and 606 H wells.

And the Yeah Yeah 501 and 502 H wells will be drilled from the surface hole location in the NW/4 NE/4 Unit $B$ of Section 10 , the bottom hole location in the $S E / 4$ SE/4 of Section 15. And the Yeah Yeah 503, 601, 605 and 606 H wells will be drilled from a surface hole location in the NW/4 NE/4 Unit B of Section 10, the bottom hole location in the SW/4 SE/4 Unit O of Section 15.

And the completed interval of the Yeah Yeah 502H well will be located within 330 feet of the quarter-quarter section line separating the $W / 2 \mathrm{E} / 2$ and $\mathrm{E} / 2 \mathrm{E} / 2$ of Sections 10 and 15 to allow for the creation of a 640 acre standard horizontal spacing unit.

And in case number 22927, COG has applied for an order pooling all uncommitted interests within the Ojo Chiso Bone Spring Pool underlying a 640 acre more or less standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the $W / 2$ of Sections 10 and 15, 22 South, Range 34 East in Lea County.

And the $W / 2$ unit will be dedicated to the Yeah Yeah Federal Com Number $504 \mathrm{H}, 505 \mathrm{H}, 602 \mathrm{H}, 603 \mathrm{H}, 604 \mathrm{H}$ and 607 H wells. And the Yeah Yeah 504,602 and 708 H wells will be drilled from a surface hole location in the NW/4 NW/4 Unit $C$ of Section 10 to a bottom hole location in the $S E / 4$ SW/4 Unit N, Section 15.

And the Yeah Yeah 505, 603 and -- will be drilled from a surface hole location in the NW/4 NW/4 Unit C of

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Section 10 to a bottom hole location in the $S W / 4$ SW/4 of Unit N, Section 15.

And in order to make a 640 acre spacing unit, there is also proximity tracts in the preceding interval as the Yeah Yeah Federal Com Number 504 H well will be located within 330 feet of the quarter-quarter section line separating the $W / 2 \mathrm{~W} / 2$ and $E / 2 \mathrm{~W} / 2$ of Sections 10 and 15.

And the exhibit package that we submitted to the Division contains Exhibit $A$, the land professional Mackayla Stone's testimony and related land exhibits which include the application, proposed notice of hearing, $C-102 s$ for the wells, the land tract ownership interest and a list of all interests to be pooled, as well as the well proposal letter and chronology of contacts with the interest owners.

Exhibit B geology testimony from William Schellenbach which includes location maps, Second and Third Bone Spring structure map, cross section map, and stratigraphic cross section.

And then finally, for both cases, Exhibit G, which is a self-affirmed statement from my partner, Dana Hardy, pointing out we sent notice letters to the interested parties, charge (inaudible) and return receipts received, and then an affidavit of pulbication from the legal staff at the Hobbs News Sun showing it was timely published on July 15, 2022.

And with that, $I$ ask that Exhibits $A, B$ and $C$ be admitted into the record in case numbers 22926 and 22927 and that these cases be taken under advisement.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
Mr. Garcia, questions?
TECHNICAL EXAMINER GARCIA: No questions.
HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. So Ms. McLean,
let's look at your -- I think I'm looking at the first case, 926, the exhibit packet, I'm on Pages 21 and 22.

MS. McLEAN: All right.
HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: You have a typo here on 21 -- tract 3, that should be Township 22 South. Anyway, what I'm more concerned about is you list, I think, nine working interest owners in your recapitulation rather than COG. You don't indicate which of these are committed or uncommitted.

The next page you have a pooling notification list here with three working interest owners. So am I making a logical leap here to say that all the other working interest owners are committed and not being pooled?

MS. McLEAN: I believe that the one on Page 21 , those are committed. And then the other working interest owners, we notified them. Everyone was locatable. They received our notice letter of the hearing and, you know, were contacted and those are the ones that need to be
pooled.
HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So on Page 22, those are the only three out of the nine working interest owners of COG who need to be pooled?

MS. McLEAN: I believe that is correct.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. I just don't
like making logical leaps because I'm not good at them.
MS. McLEAN: Would you like us to submit something else to that effect.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Highlight them or asterisk them or something. So you are going to correct that township on Page 21, just asterisk which of those -you can do it on a recapitulation, just indicate which of these are being pooled.

Now I'm going to take a little tangent here, so hang on, Ms. McLean. Mr. Bruce, on are you on the phone.

MR. BRUCE: I'm afraid so.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So later on today we are going to consider Mewbourne cases 22633.

MR. BRUCE: Okay.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: And others. The way I look at the map, those units are directly south of these units.

MR. BRUCE: Oh, I wasn't aware of that. I will say that the ones I'm handling were originally started --
filed by Dana Hardy.
HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Oh.

MR. BRUCE: A conflict developed, so I took over representation of Mewbourne. Now that --

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Okay. My point is, what caught my attention was, you are trying to pool the same three people in your unit as COG is seeking to pool in these units.

However COG has figured out -- and two of these parties are actually minors with guardians -- and they have each party in a different address than what Mewbourne used, and COG was able to locate these folks.

MR. BRUCE: Yup, that's --
HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: So I don't have to refer back to the case later, $I$ am just letting you know in advance.

MR. BRUCE: Thank you very much. Perhaps the easiest thing to do, I could use COG addresses.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: You could.
MR. BRUCE: And that would entail a -- if I could just get it continued to September 1, because otherwise there is no opposition to the case.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: We'll get to those cases later. I was just giving you a heads up.

MR. BRUCE: Thank you very much.

MS. McLEAN: We are happy to e-mail this to Mr.

Bruce.

MR. BRUCE: Thank you very much.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: And I will say, Ms.
McLean, that your land person's description of contacts with the parties were very thorough.

MS. McLEAN: Thank you.

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: A lot of detail and we usually don't get it. Explains why people aren't signing on, for a lot of interesting reasons.

Thank you. Again, any questions, Mr. Garcia?
TECHNICAL EXAMINER GARCIA: No other questions.
HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Are there any other
interested persons for case 22926, 927?
(No audible response.)

HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Hearing none, the exhibits will be admitted into the record and cases will be taken under advisement and the revised Page 21 of your exhibits would be helpful.

MS. McLEAN: Yes, sir. We will get that in.
HEARING EXAMINER BRANCARD: Thank you.
(Exhibits admitted.)
