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1	HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: With that,
2	we're on Item Number 55, Case 22744.
3	MS. VANCE: Good morning, Mr I'm
4	sorry, Mr. Brancard. Good morning Mr. Hearing
5	Examiner, Mr. Lowe. Paula Vance with the Santa Fe
6	office of Holland & Hart on behalf of the applicant,
7	Matador Production Company.
8	HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay. We have
9	an entry of appearance here from Avant Operating.
10	MS. BENNETT: Good morning, Mr. Examiner
11	and Mr. Lowe. Deana Bennett on behalf of Avant.
12	HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Thank you.
13	Does Avant have any objections to this
14	case going forward by affidavit?
15	MS. BENNETT: No, Mr. Examiner. Avant
16	does not have any objections and I don't intend to
17	ask any questions. We're just I'm just entering
18	our appearance to preserve any rights. Thank you.
19	HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: All right.
20	So Avant is the successor to WHWL; is that
21	correct, Ms. Bennett?
22	MS. BENNETT: That is a question I don't
23	have the answer to, but I'm happy to look into that
24	if I need to.
25	HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay. And you
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1	know it was asserted in the application?
2	MS. VANCE: We included that in our
3	it's our understanding that's the nature of the
4	relationship and I believe it's in Exhibit or Sub
5	Exhibit C-3 at the bottom there. And it may also
6	I believe we also covered that in Sub Exhibit C-6,
7	if you have that up and available. But that's our
8	understanding or least that's my understanding.
9	MS. BENNETT: And I'm happy to agree to
10	that, subject to check.
11	HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay.
12	MS. BENNETT: But I did have
13	communications with Avant and they didn't have any
14	objections to the application or anything stated in
15	the application. So I'm happy to agree to
16	Ms. Vance's characterization and then double-check
17	if I need to.
18	HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Thank you. I
19	just wanted to clarify a bit, but quite clearly
20	Avant has received notice, has entered an
21	appearance, and does not have an objection so we can
22	go forward here.
23	Again, any other entries of appearance for
24	22744?
25	MS. BENNETT: And Mr. Examiner, this is
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1	Deana Bennett again. I'm going to go ahead and drop
2	off just because I have to get to a meeting so I
3	apologize.
4	HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Thank you.
5	MS. VANCE: Thanks, Ms. Bennett.
6	HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Please go
7	ahead, Ms. Vance.
8	MS. VANCE: Okay. Thank you.
9	In case 22744, Matador seeks to pool an
10	uncommitted interest within the Bone Spring
11	formation, Pool Code 30213 underlying a standard
12	320-acre horizontal spacing unit comprised of the
13	E/2E/2 of Sections 28 and 33, Township 20 South,
14	Range 33 East, Lea County in New Mexico.
15	Matador seeks to dedicate the spacing unit
16	to the proposed Gavilon Fed Com 104H well, Gavilon
17	Fed Com 114H well, Gavilon Fed Com, 124H well, and
18	the Gavilon Fed Com 134H well.
19	In this case, we have provided the
20	compensatory pooling checklist as well as the
21	affidavit and testimony of Landman Isaac Evans and
22	Geologist Andrew Parker, both of whom have
23	previously testified before the division. And their
24	credentials have been accepted as a matter of
25	record.

1	Mr. Evan's affidavit is Exhibit C, which
2	includes Sub Exhibit C-1, the C-102s; C-2, the
3	landman tract map; C-3, a list of uncommitted
4	working interest owners; C-4, a list of overriding
5	royalty interests, C-5, sample well proposal letters
6	and AFE and C-6, chronology of Contacts.
7	This is followed by Mr. Parker's affidavit
8	and testimony which is Exhibit D and Sub Exhibit
9	D-1, a locator map; D2, Bone Spring subsea
10	structure; and D3, Bone Spring structural
11	cross-section.
12	In this case, Mr. Parker did not indicate
13	any faulting, pinch outs, or other geological
14	impediments to horizontal drilling these wells. And
15	lastly, our Exhibit E, a self-affirmed statement of
16	notice with a sample letter, with a sample letter
17	that was timely mailed on April 15th, 2022. And
18	Exhibit F, the affidavit of notice of publication
19	which was timely published on April 19th, 2022.
20	And unless there are any questions, I
21	would ask that all exhibits and sub exhibits be
22	accepted into the record, and that Case 22744 be
23	taken under advisement by the Division at this time.
24	And I stand by
25	HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Thank you.

1	MS. VANCE: yeah, for any questions.
2	HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Mr. Lowe, any
3	questions?
4	TECHNICAL EXAMINER LOWE: Good morning,
5	Ms. Vance.
6	MS. VANCE: Good morning, Mr. Lowe.
7	TECHNICAL EXAMINER LOWE: I have few
8	questions on actually one question on your C-102s
9	for all these wells. It looks like just from what I
10	see on your C-102s, there all in the same location.
11	They're right on top of each other. Is that just a,
12	I mean, I didn't notice the C-102s indicate the
13	surface location, the bottom hole location appear to
14	be moved, but I don't know if the take points are
15	noted but they're noted in that lat. long.
16	information.
17	MS. VANCE: That's correct.
18	TECHNICAL EXAMINER LOWE: I was just
19	curious to know, are they all stacked together, is
20	that's what's going on?
21	MS. VANCE: Yes. And I believe if you go
22	to Exhibit D-3, you can see how Matador intends to
23	drill these wells with separation between each of
24	the laterals through the vertical depth.
25	TECHNICAL EXAMINER LOWE: What exhibit is

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1	that one?
2	MS. VANCE: Exhibit D-3, the structural
3	cross-section. You go there, you can see how
4	Matador intends to drill these. They've got, if you
5	look to the right-hand side, you can see 104H, the
6	target; 114H well, the target; 124H well, the
7	target; and the 134H, the well target.
8	TECHNICAL EXAMINER LOWE: Okay. Thank
9	you.
LO	MS. VANCE: Thanks, Mr. Lowe.
L1	TECHNICAL EXAMINER LOWE: I don't have any
L 2	further questions.
L 3	HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Thank you.
L <b>4</b>	My only nit is it doesn't take me much to
L 5	get confused, and I got confused in Mr. Feldewert's
L 6	statement. He refers to the publication notice as
L 7	Exhibit E. I think it is actually Exhibit F.
L 8	MS. VANCE: You're correct. I apologize.
L 9	I am happy to refile that with the correction on
20	there, if you'd like, Mr. Brancard.
21	HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: I think that's
22	fine.
23	MS. VANCE: I will make sure that we
24	would you like me to refile that?
25	HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Yeah, that will

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1	be great, actually.
2	MS. VANCE: Okay. It was an oversight on
3	my part. Sorry about that.
4	HEARING OFFICER BRANCARD: Okay.
5	Are there any other interested persons for
6	case 2744?
