COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC LANDS' RESPONSE IN OPPOSITION TO NORTHERN PACIFIC OIL & GAS INC.'S REQUEST FOR CONTINUANCE

Stephanie Garcia Richard, Commissioner of Public Lands of the State of New Mexico (the "Commissioner") and the New Mexico State Land Office, by and through undersigned counsel, hereby files this response in opposition to the request for continuance filed on July 4, 2023 by Northern Pacific Oil & Gas, Inc. ("Northern Pacific"). For the following reasons, the hearing examiner should deny Northern Pacific's request and hold a contested hearing on Nordstrand Engineering Inc.'s ("Nordstrand") application as scheduled on July 6, 2023.

Under the adjudicatory rules for hearings, motions to continue must be filed "no later than 48 hours prior to time the hearing is set to begin, unless the reasons for requesting a continuance arise after the deadline, in which case the party shall file the motion as expeditiously as possible after becoming aware of the need for a continuance." 19.15.4.13(C) NMAC. The hearing in the above titled case is currently set for July 6, 2023, after the completion of the regular hearing docket scheduled for that day. *Pre-hearing Order*, Case No. 23551 (filed June 5, 2023). Northern Pacific filed its motion at 9:28 p.m.

on July 4, 2023, less than 48 hours before the schedule hearing. *See* Email from Marlene Salvidrez, EMNRD to Sharon Shaheen, attorney for Nordstrand Engineering, and Richard H. Moore, State Land Office July 4, 2023 (attached as Exhibit 1).

Moreover, Northern Pacific's stated reason for requesting a continuance, it's inability to find an attorney without conflicts, is unpersuasive. See Letter Requesting Continuance, Case No. 23551 (filed July 4, 2023). Northern Pacific has been aware of Nordstrand's application since at least May 25, when Nordstrand's pre-hearing statement was served on Santiago Garcia, CEO of Northern Pacific. Additionally, the Commissioner filed her complaint concerning the well at issue in Nordstrand's application on February 14, 2023 and that complaint was served on Northern Pacific's registered agent on February 22, 2023 and again on April 24, 2023. See Verified Complaint, D-101-CV-2023-00360 (filed Feb. 14, 2023); Certificate of Service and Proof of Service of Process, D-101-CV-2023-00360 (filed Mar. 3, 2023); Certificate of Service and Proof of Service of Process, D-101-CV-2023-00360 (filed Apr. 27, 2023). Northern Pacific has been aware of the lawsuit concerning this well for several months and Nordstrand's application concerning this well for at the very least six weeks and has had months to seek counsel. For this reason, the Commissioner stands ready to proceed by hearing on July 6, 2023 and requests that the hearing examiner deny the request for continuance.
