## AMENDED PRE-HEARING ORDER

This Amended Pre-Hearing Order follows an Unopposed Motion to Amend Pre-hearing Order filed by V-F Petroleum Inc. on October 11, 2023. This matter comes before an Oil Conservation Division ("Division") Hearing Examiner ("Examiner").

- 1. Cases 23874 and 23875 shall be consolidated and set for hearing with case numbers 23825-23827. The hearing will commence on January 4, 2023, following the completion of the Division's regular hearing docket and continue as necessary through completion.
  - 2. The hearing will be recorded and transcribed by a court reporter.
- 3. The hearing will be conducted in a hybrid fashion, both in-person at the Energy, Minerals, Natural Resources Department, Wendell Chino Building, Pecos Hall, 1220 South St. Francis Drive, 1st Floor, Santa Fe, NM 87505 and via the WebEx virtual meeting platform (sign-in information will be sent to the parties closer to the date of the hearing). The Examiner may modify the format of the hearing consistent with the available resources and public distancing directives in place at the time of the hearing.
- 4. The parties shall file, with the pre-hearing statement required by 19.15.4.13.B NMAC, the following additional information, all of which is due by 5 p.m. no later than seven (7) calendar days before the hearing:

- a. a list of material facts not in dispute;
- b. a list of disputed facts and issues;
- c. identification of the witnesses and their qualifications; and
- d. a full narrative of the direct testimony and exhibits for each witness.
- 5. Any evidentiary objections to the filed direct testimony or any exhibit shall be filed by 5 p.m. no later than two (2) calendar days before the hearing and will be addressed at the commencement of the hearing.
- 6. All witnesses filing direct testimony shall attend the hearing and will be subject to cross examination by counsel for the parties and the Division Examiners.
- 7. Any requests for continuances or status conferences shall be filed in writing through the Division fee portal.
