
**ENTRY OF APPEARANCE AND NOTICE OF INTERVENTION**

Luck of Beatty & Wozniak, P.C., and hereby enter their appearances on behalf of the New Mexico Oil and Gas Association (“NMOGA”) in the above-referenced matter, and hereby gives notice that it intervenes in this matter pursuant to 19.15.4.11 NMAC. NMOGA has standing to intervene because it is a coalition of oil and natural gas companies, individuals, and stakeholders, representing over 2,000 members directly affected by the proposed rule changes. 
