**ORDER STAYING PROCEEDINGS**

THESE MATTERS come before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (Division) on reliable information received on August 5, 2024, that the Parties have negotiated a settlement and are dismissing their cases. Being otherwise fully apprised of the matter, the Hearing Examiner:

**FINDS AND ORDERS:**

1. On May 30, 2024, the Division filed a Pre-Hearing Order in response to the Parties *Uncontested Motion to Consolidate Cases and Set Contested Hearing Date*. The contested hearing was scheduled to commence on August 7, 2024.
2. On July 29, 2024 the Division denied the Parties' *Uncontested Motion to Vacate*.
3. On July 31, 2024 the Division denied the Parties' Joint Motion to Reconsider in part because no compelling information was offered to support the requested relief.
4. On August 6, 2024, Permian Resources Operating, LLC filed an Unopposed Notice of Dismissal in Case Nos.: 24266-24271, 24413-24415 and 24417-24419.
5. As counsel for Mewbourne is physically unable to file similar pleadings in Case Nos.: 24545-24550, these cases are hereby stayed.
