

**ORDER GRANTING OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION'S  
MOTION TO VACATE**

This matter, having come before the Chairman of the Oil Conservation Commission (“OCC”) pursuant to 19.15.4.16(A) NMAC on the motion of the Oil Conservation Division (“OCD”) to vacate and reschedule the hearing on the merits of the above captioned matters currently scheduled for September 23-27, 2024. (“the Motion”), and the Chairman, having considered written arguments of the parties, noting the unavailability of certain OCD witnesses as represented in the Motion, noting the need to accommodate the upcoming holiday schedule and a separate pending rulemaking hearing, and being otherwise fully advised, finds that the Motion is meritorious and that the hearing should be rescheduled to begin on and at the OCC’s regularly scheduled meeting on February 20, 2025, and to continue thereafter on consecutive days unless and until otherwise ordered.
