OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION'S NOTICE OF INTENT TO PRESENT TECHNICAL REBUTTAL TESTIMONY OF BRANDON POWELL

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("OCD") submits this Notice of Rebuttal Testimony pursuant to 19.15.3.11(B) NMAC.

I. SUMMARY OF REBUTTAL

The OCD seeks to rebut and address the testimony of NMOGA witnesses supporting specific sections of NMOGA's proposed redline. OCD's comments are detailed in OCD Exhibit 11.
