**OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION'S
MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING TO FEBRUARY 13, 2025**

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“OCD”) moves to reschedule the continue the hearing in this matter to February 13, 2025, and states the following in support thereof:

1. On October 11, 2024, OCD docketed the Notice of Violation issued to POCO RESOURCES, LLC (“POCO”), OGRID #373121, and served the docketing notice on POCO by certified mail and electronic mail.
2. OCD in the docketing notice stated that the informal resolution period had expired without resolution of the NOV.
3. OCD began communications with the Operator in an attempt informally resolve the Notice of Violation.
4. OCD and the Operator are close to coming to an agreement. Therefore, the parties need more time to continue getting the settlement agreement executed.
5. OCD requests to continue the hearing date to February 13, 2025.
