## **SITE BACKGROUND**

- **Site Assessment:** 1/94
- **Excavation:** 6/94

Miles Federal #1A (Site) is managed pursuant to the procedures set forth in the document entitled, "Remediation Plan for Groundwater Encountered during Pit Closure Activities" (Remediation Plan, El Paso Natural Gas Company / El Paso Field Services Company, 1995). This remediation plan was conditionally approved by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) in correspondence dated November 30, 1995; and the OCD approval conditions were adopted into El Paso CGP Company (EPCGP's) program methods. Currently, the site is operated by Cross Timbers Energy, LLC and is active.

The site is located on Federal land. Several Site investigations were conducted from 1994 to 1999. Monitoring wells were installed in 1994 (MW-1) and 1999 (MW-2 and MW-3). A temporary piezometer was installed in 1997 (PZ-1). Free product recovery has been periodically conducted at the Site. Currently, groundwater sampling is conducted on a semi-annual basis. Free product was not observed in 2013.

## **SUMMARY OF 2013 ACTIVITIES**

In July 2013, a Site survey was completed to re-develop a base Site map and to confirm the accuracy of existing monitoring well elevations and locations.

On June 5, September 10, and December 11, 2013, water levels were gauged at MW-1, MW-2, and MW-3 and groundwater samples were collected from MW-1, MW-2, and MW-3 well using a HydraSleeve™ (HydraSleeve); a disposable, no-purge passive groundwater sampling device. The HydraSleeves were set during the previous sampling event approximately 0.5 feet above termination depth of the monitoring wells using a suspension tether and weights to collect a sample from the screened interval. Groundwater samples were placed into laboratory supplied sample containers, packed on ice and shipped under standard chain of custody protocols to Test America Laboratories in Corpus Christi, Texas where they were analyzed for benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and total xylenes (BTEX). A selective free product recovery sock kit was removed from monitoring well MW-1 during the June 2013 monitoring event. Additional field parameters were collected including dissolved oxygen, temperature, conductivity, pH, and ORP using a YSI multi-parameter instrument. The de minimis water remaining in HydraSleeves was combined in a waste container and transferred to an off-site 55-gallon drum for later disposal by Safety-Kleen.

## **RESULTS**

- The groundwater flow direction is generally to the northwest at the Site (see Figures 2, 4, and 6).
- Concentrations of benzene in groundwater collected from MW-1 remained above the New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission (NMWQCC) standard during each of the three 2013 quarterly sampling events. Total xylenes remained above the NMWQCC standard in the June and September sampling, but was below standard in the December sampling event. Toluene and ethylbenzene were not detected above standards during any sampling event in 2013.
- BTEX constituents were not detected in groundwater samples collected from MW-2 during each of the three events.
- BTEX constituents were not detected in samples collected from MW-3 during each of the three events.

## **PLANNED FUTURE ACTIVITIES**

Following the completion of a Site access agreement with the current Site operator, the installation of additional monitoring wells is planned at the Site to further assess the extent of dissolved phase hydrocarbons and to confirm and/or further define the groundwater gradient at the Site. MW-1, MW-2, MW-3, and the newly installed monitoring wells will be sampled on a semi-annual basis.

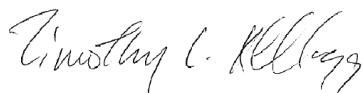


