

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*
This release was caused when a switch failed at the wellhead. Vacuum trucks were dispatched to recover all standing fluid and dispose of at an NMOCD approved facility. Repairs were made to the wellhead.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
This release impacted the pad primarily and a small area of the pasture. The pad was scrapped and Microblaze was sprayed in the pasture. Concho will have the spill site sampled to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
