In response to your request for information about BP monitoring of wells near some of your projects, OCD will open three files on our website. They will soon appear as 3RP-1055 (GCU A#142E), 3RP-1056 (Fields A#7A), and 3RP-1057 (Sandoval GC A 001A). BP will soon provide their monitoring data for these files.

OCD approves the work plans referenced above with the following conditions.

- Use Method 8260 for BTEX instead of Method 8021B, as discussed earlier.
- Notify OCD District III staff at least 48 hours prior to start of monitoring work at each site.
- Notify OCD District III staff of changes in your proposed schedule above.
