All,

The NMOCD tracking number for the oil and produced water release which occurred at the Cockburn Fed 2 site (30-025-36282), on September 2, 2018 is **1RP-5488**.

Be advised, NMAC 19.15.29.10 states:

**(A) Reporting a major release.**

(1) The responsible party must notify the division's environmental bureau chief and the appropriate division district office verbally or by e-mail within 24 hours of discovery of the release. The notification must provide the information required on form C-141.

(2) The responsible party must also notify the appropriate division district office in writing within 15 days of discovering the release by completing and filing form C-141. The written notification must verify the prior verbal or e-mail notification and include additions or corrections to the information contained in the prior verbal or e-mail notification.

Because the release was associated with a fire, it is therefore classified as a major release and the NMOCD District 1 office, along with Jim Griswold should have been notified of the event within 24 hrs of discovery. In either case (Major or Minor), the C-141 was not received within 15 days from initial discovery as is required by [19.15.29.10 NMAC - Rp, 19.15.29.10 NMAC, 8/14/2018]. Additionally, in the future please only submit the first two pages of the C-141 document for the initial notification.
