Yes, the proposed remediation activities are approved. I will update the administrative record to reflect the approval momentarily.

However, with regards to 19.15.29.13 D (1), the restoration of the uppermost 4 ft of soils within the pad can be deferred until such time as the pad is decommissioned. That is, the production pads are not ultimately exempt from the restoration part of the rule. In this instance though, remediation activities may proceed as proposed.

Thanks for your thought and attention to the matter.

The NMOCD will be on the lookout for the report on closure activities by August 14, 2019.

Mr. Rose-Cross,

Per our conversation on May 10, 2019, the spill area that is off pad is under Table 1 limits for groundwater less than 50 feet and the area on pad only had two areas (AH-3 and AH-4) with TPH concentrations above RRAL limits. 19.15.29.13 D (1) only applies to spills in the pasture (off pad) and not to on pad spills. COG is proposing to excavate the areas represented by AH-3 and AH-4 to approximately six-inches, all other areas are below RRAL limits. Are the proposed activities approved? I appreciate you taking time to discuss this with me.

Ms. Grant,

The NMOCD has reviewed the Work Plan for the COG Stratocaster 20 Fed #3H (1RP-5255) release which occurred on 10/22/2018. The Division approves the workplan with a few caveats:

- The Division is satisfied the areas meant to be represented by samples AH-5, AH-6 and AH-7 did not contain soils with any constituents above the recommended remedial action levels (RRAL) and that no further action is required within those areas.
- The Division agrees that because the areas represented by samples AH-3 and AH-4 contained soils with TPH concentrations above the RRAL levels, that the soils within that area should be removed and remediated.
- However, pursuant to 19.15.29.13 D (1)
  - "The reclamation must contain a minimum of four feet of non-waste containing, uncontaminated, earthen material with chloride concentrations less than 600 mg/kg as analyzed by EPA Method 300.0, or other test methods approved by the division. The soil cover must include a top layer, which is either the background thickness of topsoil or one foot of suitable material to establish vegetation at the site, whichever is greater."
- Therefore, the areas represented by samples AH-1 and AH-2 require remediation due to the reported chloride concentrations in those locations up to 1.5 ft depth.

To fulfill closure requirements for this site (1RP-5255) the NMOCD requests that all areas meant to be represented by samples AH-1 through AH-4 be remediated to 1.5 ft and that sufficient bottom and sidewall samples be taken to demonstrate compliance with NMAC 19.15.29.
