DeAnn,

The BLM reviewed the closure request, we're not too concerned with the lack of remediation. Our only issue will be that if hydrocarbons have been left on the surface and there is residue left on surface, and the site is inspected in the future, surface impacts may need to be addressed. As for the chlorides the levels left are greater than the 600 mg/l, but such a minor amount, State surface, if they are happy, we'll address at abandonment reclamation. We will approve closure at this time.
