My apologies for the delay in getting back to you. Attached is the revised Figure 4. The area was accidentally shifted to the west instead of over the release/excavation footprint. As you can see in the photos, the flowlines were moved prior to the excavation activities. All final confirmation samples, which were collected every 200 square feet, showed benzene, total BTEX, and chloride concentrations below the RRALs.

Question, while reviewing the COG Tusk Federal #2H Closure Request, I noticed that the release area depicted in Figure 3 suggests that fluids spread over the area with buried pipeline. Then in Figure 4, the excavation and sampling area all appear to have taken place just to the east of the buried pipeline. I understand why you would not excavate around the buried pipelines, but were there any soil samples taken in that area? The OCD would like to know if there is any soils above the RRAL being left behind in the area. If so, COG will need to request a deferral or somehow remediate those soils.

Thanks so much for your time and attention to the site remediation and I look forward to working with you to close the site.
