Dear Mr. Patterson:

On July 9, 1990, you contacted the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) Environmental Bureau about permitting a treating plant east of Crossroads, New Mexico in section 26, township 9S, range 36E. During your conversation with the OCD, you requested a copy of OCD's guidelines for the permitting of treating plants.

The OCD does not currently have specific guidelines for the permitting of treating plants. All treating plants must operate in conformity with the provisions contained in OCD Rule-312 on pages E-11 through E-13 of the State of New Mexico, Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department, Oil Conservation Division Rules and Regulations. Enclosed you will find a copy of Rule-312. In addition, you will also find a copy of the OCD "Guidelines For Permit Application, Design and Construction of Waste Storage/Disposal Pits" to assist you in preparing your treating plant application. Although these guidelines were prepared specifically for waste disposal pits, most of these guidelines will also apply to your treating plant since your proposed facility will contain a below grade lined pit.
