

Hydrostatic Test Waters

Dear Mr. Eustice:

Natural Gas Pipeline Company of America's hydrostatic test water discharge permit will expire January 31, 1994. This "general" discharge permit was granted January 23, 1984 and renewed on November 17, 1988. Natural requests renewal of this permit with the following conditions:


1. Volume per test shall not exceed 100,000 gallons
2. Only fresh water (preferably 2,000 ppm Total Dissolved Solids or better) shall be utilized in hydrostatic testing.
3. No discharges will be made into any lake, perennial stream, river or their respective tributaries that may be seasonal.
4. A monthly report, summarizing activity, will be filed within 30 days and shall contain the following information:
 - A. Location of test- Section, Township and Range.
 - B. Date of test.
 - C. Volume of Discharge.
 - D. Source of test water- Owner's name and location of water source- Section, Township and Range.


