The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has completed a revision of Pride Refining, Inc.'s (PRI) December 1, 1994 "SOIL REMEDIATION PLAN FOR PRIDE REFINING, YATES FIELD: (LEASE-YOUNG DEER WOLFCAMP) HARVEY YATES CO.". This document contains PRI's plan for remediation of soils contaminated as a result of a spill of barrels of crude oil from a pipeline operated by PRI.

The above referenced spill remediation plan is approved with the following conditions:

- 1 All soil samples for verification of closure or completion of remedial activities will be sampled and analyzed for benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, xylene (BTEX) and total petroleum hydrocarbons in accordance with the OCD's "GUIDELINES FOR REMEDIATION OF LEAKS, SPILLS AND RELEASES".

**N/E:** A field headspace measurement of 100 parts per million (mg/l) of total organic vapor, if determined in accordance with OCD guidelines, may be substituted for a laboratory analysis of the concentrations of BTEX.

On completion of remedial actions, PRI will submit to the OCD for approval a final report which will contain the final results of the remedial activities. The reports will include description of the activities, the final sampling results and the concentrations and application rates of any materials and additives used to enhance bioremediation of contaminants.

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has completed a review of Pride Refining, Inc.'s (PRI) December 1, 1994 "SOIL REMEDIATION PLAN FOR PRIDE REFINING, YATES FIELD:(LEASE-YOUNG DEEP#1 & WOLFCAMP) HARVEY YATES CO.". This document contains PRI's plan for remediation of soils contaminated as a result of a spill of 40 barrels of crude oil from a pipeline operated by PRI.

The above referenced spill remediation plan is approved with the following conditions:

1. All soil samples for verification of closure or completion of remedial activities will be sampled and analyzed for benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, xylene (BTEX) and total petroleum hydrocarbons in accordance with the OCD's "GUIDELINES FOR REMEDIATION OF LEAKS, SPILLS AND RELEASES".

**NOTE:** A field headspace measurement of 100 parts per million (mg/l) of total organic vapor, if determined in accordance with OCD guidelines, may be substituted for a laboratory analysis of the concentrations of BTEX.

2. Upon completion of remedial actions, PRI will submit to the OCD for approval a final report which will contain the final results of the remedial activities. The reports will include a description of the activities, the final sampling results and the concentrations and application rates of any materials or additives used to enhance bioremediation of contaminants.


