This is a follow up to Charlie's note. The well is the Tecumseh #1, 18-30N-11W. Drain valve on a three hundred barrel tank froze. Lost 81 barrels of condensate. Impacted 100 feet of short vegetation about 100 feet, 10 feet wide. Then about 300 feet across a coarse grass bog, then into a cattail marsh with some open water. Booms, pads and sox are being utilized in the open water, the bog will be sprayed with surfactant and the upper 100 feet will be excavated. The running water joins the river in about three miles. Groundwater is from three feet to three inches.
