Hendrix Corporation respectfully requests administrative approval for a non-standard 80 acre gas proration unit consisting of the N/2 NE/4 Section 11, T-21-S - R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, for a Eumont gas well, the McQuatters No. 1, to be drilled in Unit B. A lease plat is attached showing the location of this well.

The McQuatters No. 1 is a replacement well for the Amoco No. 1 McQuatters which was a Eumont gas well with the same non-standard proration unit, approved by NSP 106, but was turned over to the Chevron Eunice Monument South Unit and plugged in the Eumont.

John H. Hendrix Corporation also requests administrative approval for a non-standard location for the No. 1 McQuatters. A deeper producing well already exists at the standard location of 660' FNL and 1980' FEL.

Approval of this request will protect correlative rights, promote conservation, and encourage the efficient recovery of gas reserves. The proposed proration unit will




