Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool for your Thomas Well No. 2, consisting of the NE/4 of Section 19, Township 24 South, Range 37 East.

Due to the completion of this well in the Queen formation of the Langlie-Mattix Oil Pool as well as the Yates-Seven Rivers of the Jalmat Gas Pool, I do not feel that it would be to the best interests of all concerned to grant approval of this application administratively.

In my opinion, I feel that not only the immediate offset operators should be notified, but all operators within that general area should be notified of your intention to form this unit because of the well's proximity to the Falby-Yates area and its completion in the Queen formation.

Therefore, if you desire further action on this application please advise this office and the application will be set for hearing.

Comes now Cities Service Oil Company and respectfully requests the Oil Conservation Commission to approve a non-standard gas proration unit of 160 acres, embracing the NE/4, Section 19-24S-37E, Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support of the application wishes to state the following:

1. The Cities Service Oil Company is the owner of the Thomas Lease covering the E/2, Section 19-24S-37E.
2. The Thomas No. 2 is located 2310' from North Line, 2210' from East Line, Section 19-24S-37E, and is now classified as a Langlie-Mattix oil well. It produces through open hole from 2870-3680', which includes the Yates, Seven Rivers and Queen formations. Drill stem tests during completion indicated that the Queen formation was non-productive.
3. This well meets the spacing requirements of Rule R-520 for classification as a Jalmat gas well with a non-standard gas proration unit of 160 acres.
4. All operators in Section 19 have been notified of this application and provided waivers to send to the Conservation Commission should they have no objection.
5. A plat is attached showing the above described lands.




