Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 360-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM  
Lots 1, 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, and 11 of Section 4

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your A. E. Meyer B-4 Well No. 14, located 5940 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line of Section 4, in Lot 7 of Section 4, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 360 acres.
