Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 40-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM
NW/4 NW/4 of Section 6

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your J. H. Day Well No. 2, located 660 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 6, in the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 6, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 40 acres.
