Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 240-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 20 South, Range 37 <sup>EAST</sup> South, NMPM  
Ne/4, E/2 NW/4 of Section 17

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Theodore Anderson Well No. 4, located 660 feet from the North line, and 1980 feet from the East line of Section 17, in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 17, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 240 acres.
