Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM
N/2 SW/4 and NW/4 SE/4 of Section 21

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your M. E. Wanta Well No. 2, located 1960 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line and in the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 21, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5 (b), Section 6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order A-528, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit effective April 1, 1956, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 120 acres.
