Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 19 South, Range 37 East, NMPM
N/2 of Section 21

DD&D
on W/2 NW/4
A NE/4 NW/4

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your E. Shipp Well No. 1, located 1980 feet from the north line and 1980 feet from the west line and in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 21, Township 19 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. *balance patented*

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 320-acres. This allowable will be granted from the first of the month following notification to the Oil Conservation Commission that an approved operating agreement has been reached with Humble Oil and Refining Company and the New Mexico State Land Office.
