Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 20 South, Range 36 East, NMPM
E/2 of Section 25

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your L. W. White Well No. 2, located 660 feet from the East line and 1980 feet from the South line, in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 25, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 320 acres. For the purposes of gas proration, the allowable granted herein will become

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effective the first of the month following the receipt of a duly executed copy of the pooling and operating agreement by the Proration Manager at Hobbs, New Mexico.
