My apologies. The OCD has denied the submitted Closure Report C-141 for incident # nCE2003758951 for the following reasons:

- This release is considered a major release, as it resulted in a fire, and will need to comply with 19.15.29.8, 19.15.29.9, 19.15.29.10, 19.15.29.11, 19.15.29.12, and 19.15.29.13.

Essentially, what I need from you guys are a sample(s), analytical data, and a site sampling map showing the extents of the release.
