The OCD has approved the Site Characterization and Remediation Plan for incident # NRM2012539093 with the following conditions:

- Additional samples will need to be collected at the 3' and 4' intervals in the SP 1-5 areas to
 address potential chloride migration through depth. In the event additional chloride
 contamination is discovered, the responsible party will perform additional required
 investigation/remediation.
- If no additional contamination is found, the SP5 area will also need to be remediated to a depth of greater than 2 feet.
- Confirmation samples will be collected as composite samples, representing an area of no greater than 300 square feet for floor samples and sidewall samples. At a minimum, at least one sidewall sample will need to be collected from each wall of the excavation. Individual grab samples will be collected from any wet or discolored areas.
