Armstrong Energy Corporation is requesting an extension to the current December 28, 2020 deadline for submitting a remediation work plan or closure report required in 19.15.29.12.B.(1) NMAC for the Long Tall Sally #1. The release was discovered on July 21, 2020 and initial site assessment was conducted. Depth to water verification is needed to confirm the Closure Criteria at the Site; however; due to ongoing attempts to contact the private property owner, depth to water confirmation was delayed. Armstrong Energy has been coordinating with the New Mexico Office of the State Engineer (NMOSE), United States Geological Survey (USGS), and their land department for land access for the nearby wells in order to attempt to measure the current depth to water in any accessible well. If access is denied, additional time to discuss potential remediation options impacting soil adjacent to the active tank battery would be necessary. In order to conduct potential further site assessment, depth to water verification, and submit a remediation work plan or closure report, Armstrong Energy Corporation requests an extension of this deadline until March 27, 2021.
